### **Remembrance of the Child Service**

The annual Remembrance of The Child Service was held on Wednesday, January 29th at 6:00 PM in the Chapel of the Holy Child. The service commemorates the passing of The Holy Child, Jamil at midnight (January 29/30) in 1962. This service officially begins the Second Advent Sunrise Vigil which, this year, marks the 63rd year of the birth of the Sun of Righteousness and God's Second Advent. Sunrise Divine Service is held each morning at the Church of New Epiphany at the Red Rock Consecrated Sanctuary each morning, weather permitting. On mornings when Sunrise Divine Service is not permitted due to inclement weather, Community Sunrise is held at the End

Times parsonage.

During this year's sunrise vigil, several spectacular rainbows were observed over the Sanctuary and the entire city of Reno which even caught the attention of local news stations.
