Rev. Jo Ann Hainline Passes into the Light



The Reverend Jo Ann Hainline, born into this world on November

7, 1949, in Davenport, Iowa, passed into the Light on September 17, 2023 in Reno, Nevada.

Jo Ann graduated from North Miami High School in Miami-Dade, Florida, which she attended because of national level swimming competitions. At one time she held the women's national record for the 400 meter individual medley, one of the toughest swimming events.

Later, in Des Moines, Iowa, Jo Ann attended Augustana College and the University of Iowa. She first contacted the International Community of Christ/Cosolargy in June of 1975. Inspired by many mystical experiences, she enrolled in The Academy.

By April 1976, she became a member of the Order of Monk de Jure of the Rectory Abbey, an Order which played a major role in sponsoring the publication of *The Secret Sayings of Jamil* codices of *The Sacred Teachings of Light*.

In February of 1977, Jo Ann became a member of The Ship's Company of the Feathered Serpent II, with her contribution toward the purchase of the ship, a stay sail schooner which sailed as The Community's second Ship of Light. The Ship of Light – Feathered Serpent II – voyaged during a time of both religious inspiration and spiritual prophecy for The Church from 1977 to 1980.

In May of 1978, Jo Ann made the decision to move to Reno, Nevada and become a resident member of The Community, bringing her two children, Michael Shane and Erica Jalayne. Shane and Jalayne became among the first students of The Community's Jamilian Parochial School. Jalayne was in the first graduating class.

Jo Ann enrolled in the Sacred College of Jamilian Theology, receiving first level ordination on July 22, 1978. In March 1979, she entered The Academy's First Clergy Program continuing through Liturgy III.



After settling in Reno, Jo Ann met the Reverend Bruce Kanzelmeyer, also a member of The Community. They married in October of 1986 and soon, thereafter, were blessed with two sons, Jonathan Christopher and Gabriel James.

Jo Ann received second level ordination in 1994 and was given a Special Assignment as Deacon-Overseer of the Sanctuary at the Red Rock Consecrated Sanctuary. In 2007, she was ordained at to third level as Presbyter-Overseer of the Sanctuary with the title of Reverend.

Jo Ann was the mother of four children and loved teaching. She was a Montessori-trained and credentialed teacher, teaching in Iowa and then in Reno. The love of teaching the whole child was the core of all her work as a parent, teacher and counselor/therapist. In 1993, Jo Ann received her Bachelor of Arts Degree from the University of Nevada, Reno (UNR) in General Studies, and then her Nevada Elementary Teacher's Credential in 1994.

Jo Ann received her Master's Degree in Counseling and

Educational Psychology from UNR in 1998, specializing in Marriage and Family Therapy (MFT) and School Counseling. In 2002, she received her Nevada State MFT License. She transitioned to teaching in the Washoe County School District in 1998 and then, in 2015, she became an elementary school counselor, until she retired in 2020.

In 2003, Jo Ann began working evenings and weekends for several agencies as an MFT, working with parents and children, and facilitating domestic violence and parenting classes. She opened a private practice – Insight Therapies – in 2013, where she specialized in working with foster and adopted children and blended families. Jo Ann continued counseling until her last day with us.

Jo Ann was profoundly devoted to The Community, Cosolargy and The Teachings of Light and a fierce defender of the Truth within the Sun of Righteousness. Bishop Gene Savoy, Jr. and officials of the Church performed the Anointing of the Remains of the Deceased prior to cremation in company with members of Jo Ann's family on Wednesday, September 20, 2023. A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, December 9, 2023 in the Chapel of the Holy Child.



The Views of the Spiritualist and the Materialist



“Neither the occultist generally, nor the Theosophists, reject as erroneously believed by some, the views and theories of the modern scientist. Only because these views

Truly, the astral Light of the derided Kabalists has strange and weird secrets for those who can see it; and the mysteries concealed within its waves are there, the whole body of materialists notwithstanding. These secrets, along with many other mysteries, will remain non-existent to the materialists of our age, in the same way as America was a non-existent myth for Europeans during the early part of the medieval ages, whereas Scandinavians and Norwegians had actually reached and settled in that very old 'New World, several centuries before.' ~[H. Theories of Modern Science

Some people think that being spiritual means you oppose the theories and teachings of modern science, but that is not true. While spiritual people question the theories of science, we do not reject them outright. Science has given us much in modern society. Discoveries in science and engineering have made modern buildings, bridges, and roads possible. Discoveries in modern medicine may have made many of us too dependent on drugs for healing, but it has also cured many diseases. And modern science has given us conveniences like electric washing machines, television, and automobiles. Granted, there is a negative side to all of those things, as it is with everything in the realm of matter, but there is a positive side as well. The old Yin-Yang symbol illustrates this truth quite well.

Theosophy

Madame Blavatsky founded the spiritual school known as [Theosophy](#), so she tends to relate to all things spiritual in terms of Theosophy. We should simply replace Theosophy with spiritual development to get a more general idea of what she is saying.

Render Unto Caesar

I think most spiritual schools, including Cosolargy, would agree with Blavatsky when she says that the first rule of the Theosophist is to render unto Caesar the things that are Caesars. Spiritual people do not reject the material world as useless, or evil. We do not reject all material comforts and live naked in a cave, as some did in ancient times. We are allowed to enjoy material comforts for the sake of our physical body and mind, as long as we don't get too attached to them. If you agree with those who refuse to leave their homes when told to evacuate because of wildfires, floods, or tornadoes, then you have become too attached to matter, and you need to work on that. The reason the spiritual student needs to avoid such attachments is that they can be used by the forces of darkness to pull us away from spiritual development.

Consciousness in the Brain

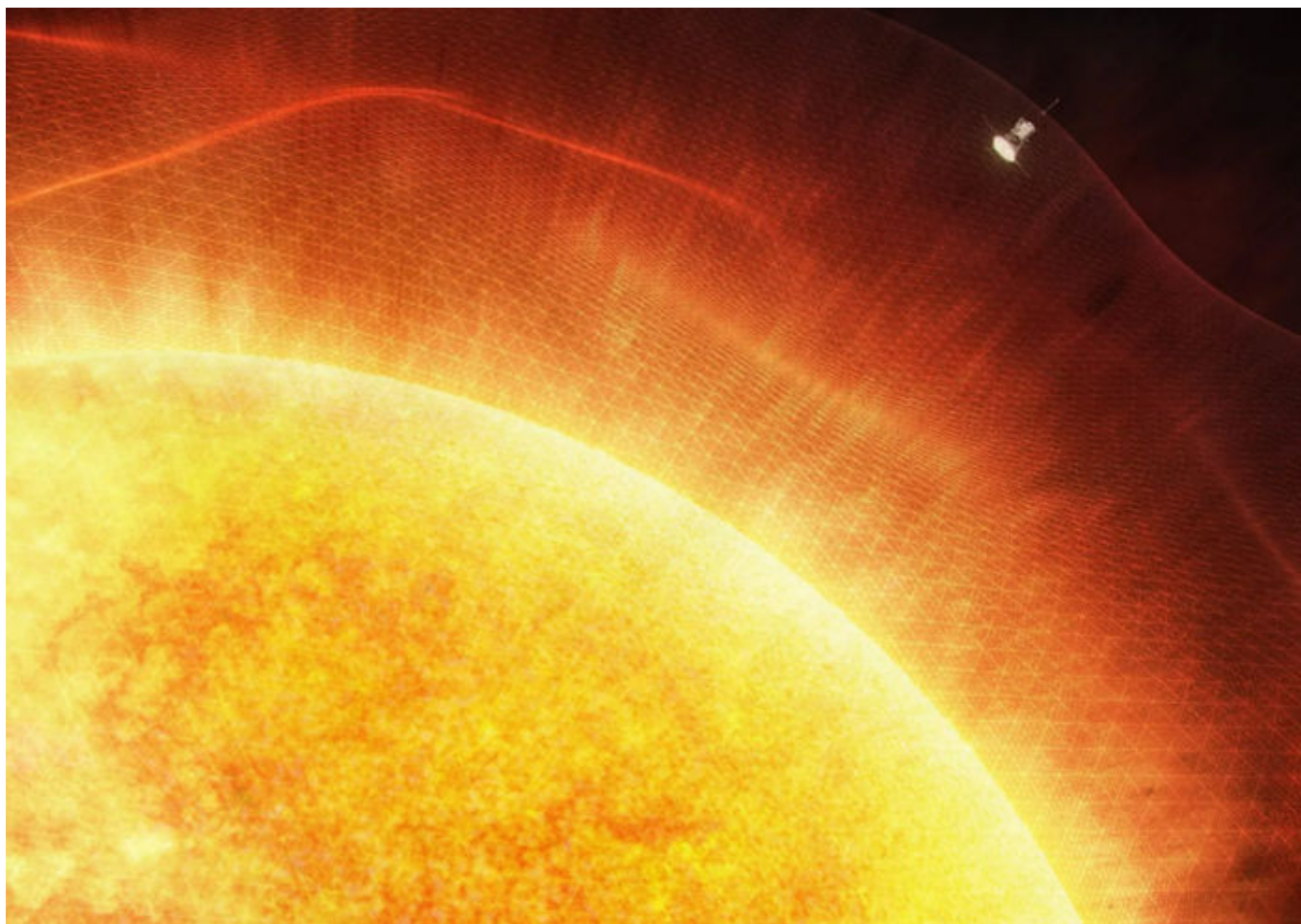

Suffice it to say that the views of consciousness are changing rapidly today. Many scientists no longer accept that it is merely a creation, or as Blavatsky calls it, a secretion of the brain. Indeed, we are getting to the point where some are starting to accept what is called "Biocentrism," which says that it is consciousness that is creating the material universe around us, or at least our view of it. This goes along with the studies in Quantum Physics that find that things are affected

by the viewer of those things. That works in both directions, of course.

The Astral Light of the Kabbalists

What Blavatsky is calling the astral Light of the Kabbalists, we would say is the Spiritual Light that comes from God, and reaches us through the intermediary of the Spiritual Sun. This light does indeed have “strange and weird secrets” for those who learn to absorb it and the knowledge hidden within it. It is, in fact, the best link available to us between the realm of spirit and the realm of matter, so we should make use of it properly, and with humility and reverence.

“First mission to ‘touch’ the sun catches the solar wind| CNN”



A solar mission that has been spiraling closer to the sun to unravel its secrets has flown near enough to our star's surface to make a key discovery.

Data from the Parker Solar Probe has uncovered the source of solar wind, a stream of energized particles that flow from the corona, or the sun's hot outer atmosphere, toward Earth.

One of the key motivations behind the mission, named for the [late astrophysicist Eugene Parker](#) and [launched in 2018](#), was to determine what the wind looks like as it forms near the sun and how it escapes the star's gravity.

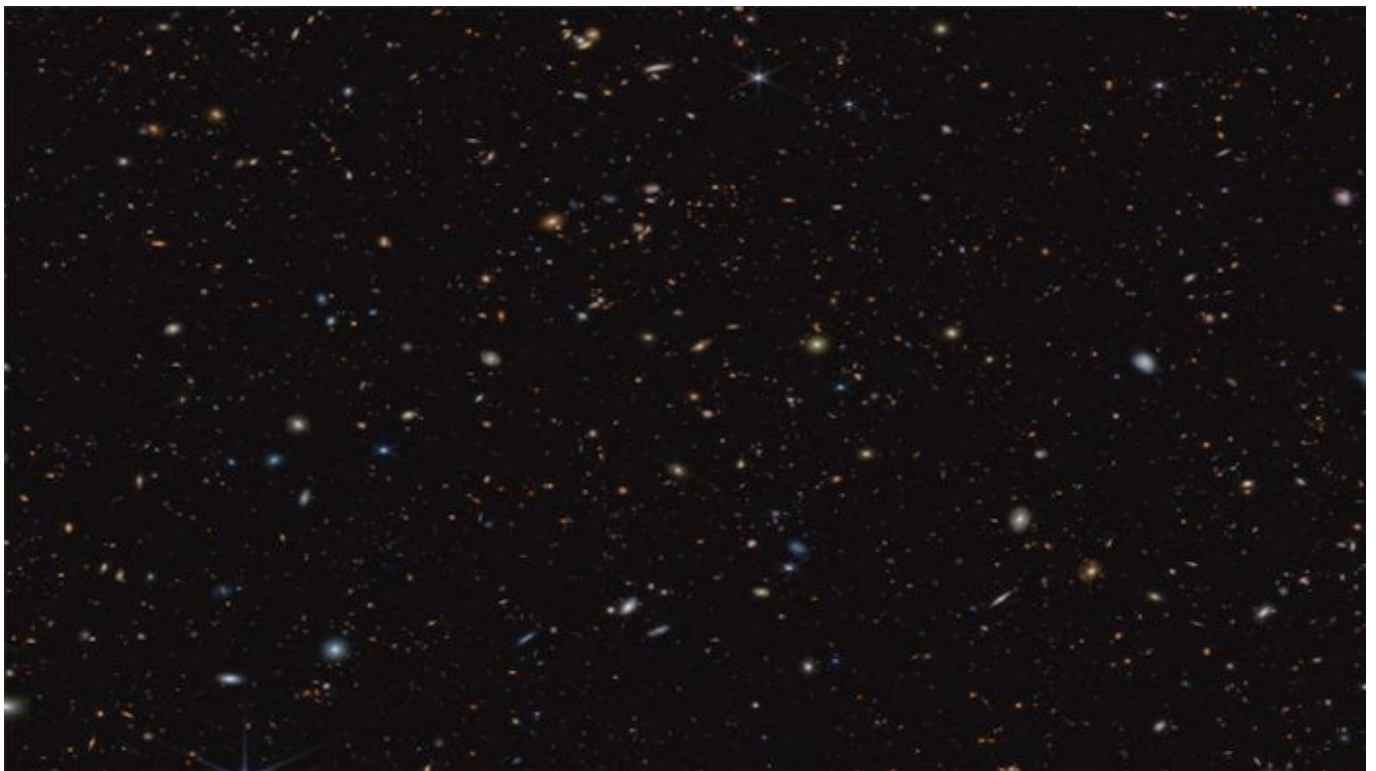
As the probe came within about 13 million miles (20.9 million kilometers) of the sun, its instruments detected fine structures of the solar wind where it generates near the photosphere, or the solar surface, and captured ephemeral

details that disappear once the wind is blasted from the corona.

“Glimpse 45,000 baby galaxies in the early universe”



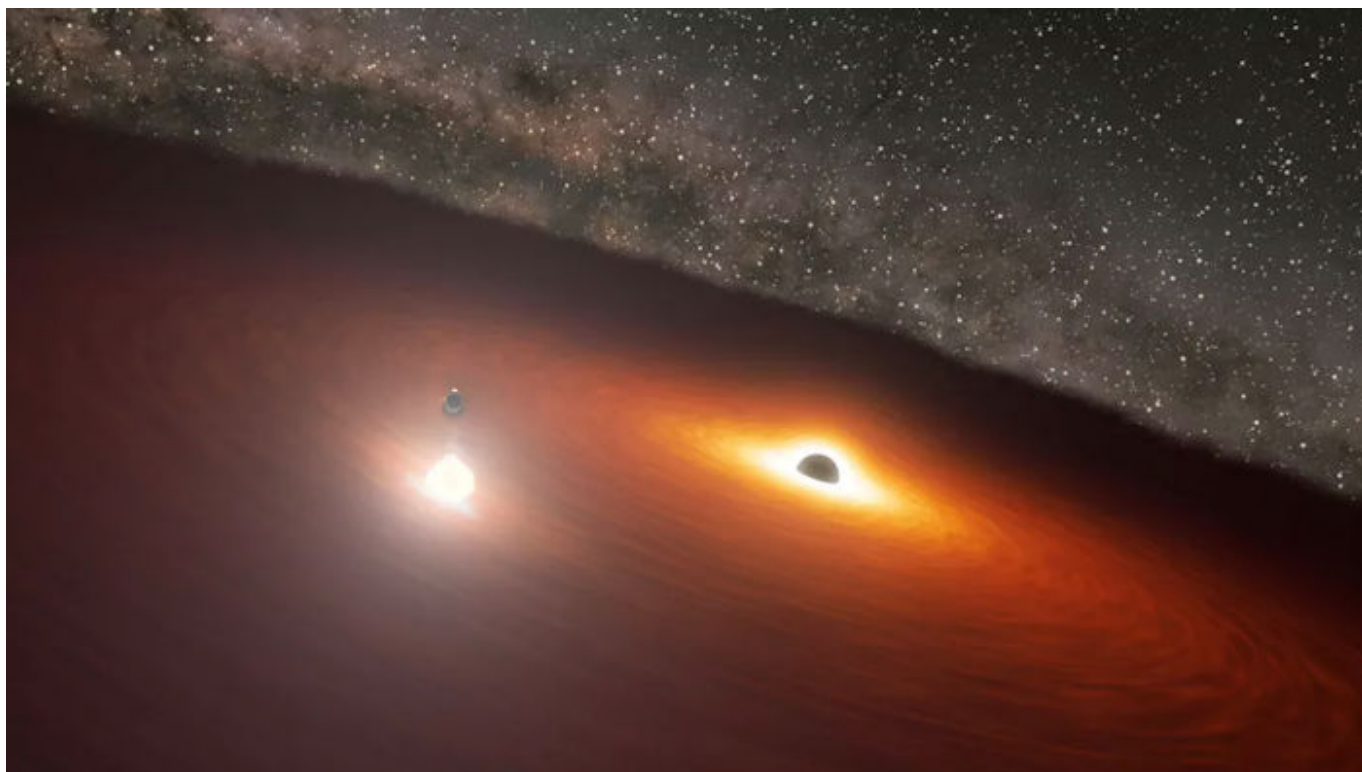
On June 5, 2023, NASA [released](#) a new composite image from the James Webb Space Telescope ([JWST](#)). It shows our universe when it was less than 600 million years old. And, you can explore *more than 45,000 baby galaxies* in this image,

Our universe is thought to be more than 13 billion years old. So – at 600 million years – the cosmos was in its infancy. The galaxies had just formed from the expanding cloud of most hydrogen gas, moving outward from the [Big Bang](#).

Astronomers have confirmed the presence of a second supermassive black hole in the turbulent heart of a distant galaxy.

**Follow the Brightness of God
Back to Our Origin**



“Out of our highest feeling, the brightness of God shines into us, which teaches us Truth, and moves us toward every virtue and in eternal love towards God. If we follow this Brightness without pause, back into that Source from whence it came forth, there we feel nothing but a quenching of our spirit and an irretrievable sinking into simple and fathomless Love. Could we continue to dwell there with our simple gaze, we should always so feel it; for our immersion and transformation in God continues without ceasing in eternity, if we have gone forth from ourselves, and God is ours in the immersion of Love. If we possess God in the immersion of Love—that is, if we are lost to ourselves—God is our own, and we are His. This immersion is essential and is closely bound up with the state of Love: and so it continues whether we sleep or whether we wake, whether we know it or whether we know it not. ... And this down-sinking is like a river, which without pause or turning back ever pours into

the sea, which is its proper resting place. So likewise when we possess God alone.” ~[John of Ruysbroeck](#)

God's Brightness Shines in Us

When we seek the Light of God, his brightness will shine in us. As Ruysbroeck says, that brightness will bring us Truth and Knowledge. Not the kind of knowledge we get from books or college classes, but the Divine Knowledge that the Gnostics called Gnosis.

Follow the Brightness

Just seeking God's Brightness (or Light) isn't enough. We must seek it always, every day, and go deeper and deeper into it with time and practice. As we do, using the techniques taught in Cosolargy, we gradually increase our level of consciousness until we reach the highest level, which is God. When we reach that level, we become one with God, one with Love, one with All. We are then a true child of the universe, but the immortal spiritual universe, not the mortal one of matter.

Sinking Into Love

I would not have chosen to call it “sinking into love,” but the idea is correct. When we enter the brightness of God's Light, we experience the feeling of universal Love. This is not a love for an individual or for humans only. Universal Love is for all beings. It is an all-consuming Love. People who have had a Near Death Experience (NDE) often mention briefly experiencing this and it usually leaves them permanently changed. They can no longer see other beings as slaves or tools of man but as spirits in a physical form that just happens to be different from our own physical form.

Immersion in God

Ruysbroeck says that total immersion in God is essential, and he is correct. To become one with God, we must become immersed

in God, immersed in His Light. Ruysbroeck's comparison of this process to a river that forever flows into the sea is an apt one. That is how we must connect with God. Of course, it will start with connecting briefly and temporarily, but advance over time until it is a permanent connection. Of course, rivers and seas are not truly eternal, yet the comparison makes the point well. So practice techniques as taught and soon you too will be connecting with the Brightness of God's Light, even if you are not consciously aware that it has happened.
