He will be speaking along with Dr. Gerald Pollack, an old colleague of his who has gained fame in recent years for his theory of fourth-phase water, and who is chairing the conference, and along with several Nobel Prize laureates. Rev. Buchanan's work on Sonatherapy and his use of water to form archetypal cymographs made him a candidate for speaking at this prestigious international conference. 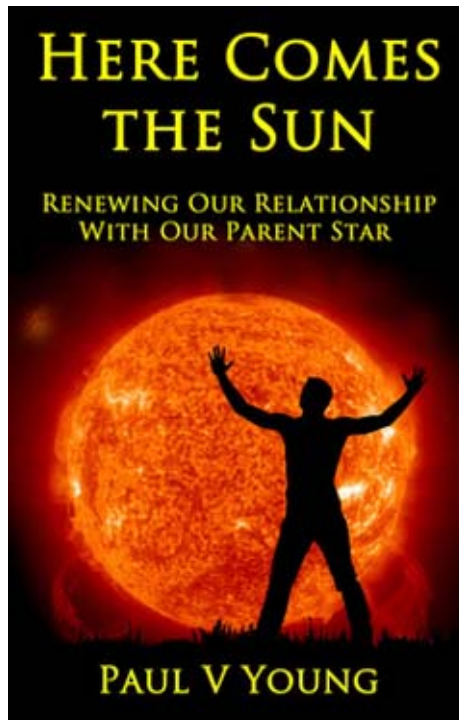

A number of prominent doctors have come out to publicly endorse the absorption of Sunlight in the human eye and skin, using common sense to avoid over exposure.

"In the scientific field during 2016 researchers are making new discoveries about the ways our planet is intimately connected to the Sun by invisible strings, and the real impact it has on our weather patterns and climate change. Quantum physics shows there may be corresponding connections on a different dimensional level that result in wormhole-type tunnels that bridge our earth to the Sun and beyond.

"Historically the star of our solar system has been honoured by the construction of megaliths such as Stonehenge and Glastonbury in England, Nabta Playa in Egypt and the Temple of the Sun in Mexico. Now alternative researchers believe there is evidence that solar power was harnessed and distributed in structures such as the pyramids and that giant obelisks such as the one at Abu Gurab were actually electrical transmitters. The concept and application of this fits perfectly with the theories of the 20th century genius Nikola Tesla. Great leaders in ancient Egypt, Greece and Rome were guided by mystical activities based on what may be called the solar sciences, and their traditions survive today within certain secretive societies.

"Authors such as James Redfield have suggested that the human body may be destined to evolve into what is known as a light body, and this is now supported by scientific research into matter being constructed of photons. Along with modern technology's steps towards transhumanism and artificial intelligence, we are witnessing the emergence of a new breed of humans referred to as Indigo children and the Super Psychic

kids. Modern day organizations such as Cosolargy suggest that the transmutation can be accomplished by the intake of the Sun's rays. [emphasis added]

Explorer Gene Savoy Appears in Catholic Textbook

Elizabeth Reece, a member of the administrative staff at the Chancellery offices of the International Community of Christ, occasionally checks the internet for new references to Gene Savoy's explorations and his other works since people will often use him as example in books they are writing about Peru or Amazonas.

In November 2014 she found a reference to "Gene Savoy" being scheduled as a topic of a high school Catholicism class at St Joseph's High School in Metuchen, NJ, and she contacted the class instructor, Thomas Cunningham:

Dear Mr.Cunningham,

I stumbled across your teachers outline for the 2014-2015 Religious Studies class at St Joseph High School. On the day of 11/25/14 you listed Gene Savoy as a topic for discussion during Catholicism. Since, I have studied and worked with Gene Savoy, (the explorer, religious scholar and teacher who established the International Community of Christ) from 1978 up to his passing in 2007 I wanted to asked if this was the same individual discussed in your class. If so would you be willing to share some details of the reactions received from your students during the discussion, or what source material they used. If it is the same person, the idea that you would offer your freshman class an opportunity to comment about him is very intriguing to me. Thank you very much, I hope this letter is not too intrusive.

This was his response:

*Hello,
The section on Gene Savoy was covered in our textbook in Chapter 4. There is a short story about Gene Savoy getting lost in the Jungle. He finds himself getting very anxious about the situation, but after settling down... He begins to pray for guidance from God. He eventually is able to find his way out of the jungle , and credits that "quiet time with God" with his trek out of the forest. My students were very interested with the incident. The textbook contains many short stories like this one...*

This led Elizabeth to a rather interesting discovery: In Catholic high school classes across the country who use the textbook *Path Through Catholicism* (Mark Link, 1991), there is a story told by Gene Savoy being used as an example that “God is present in all.”

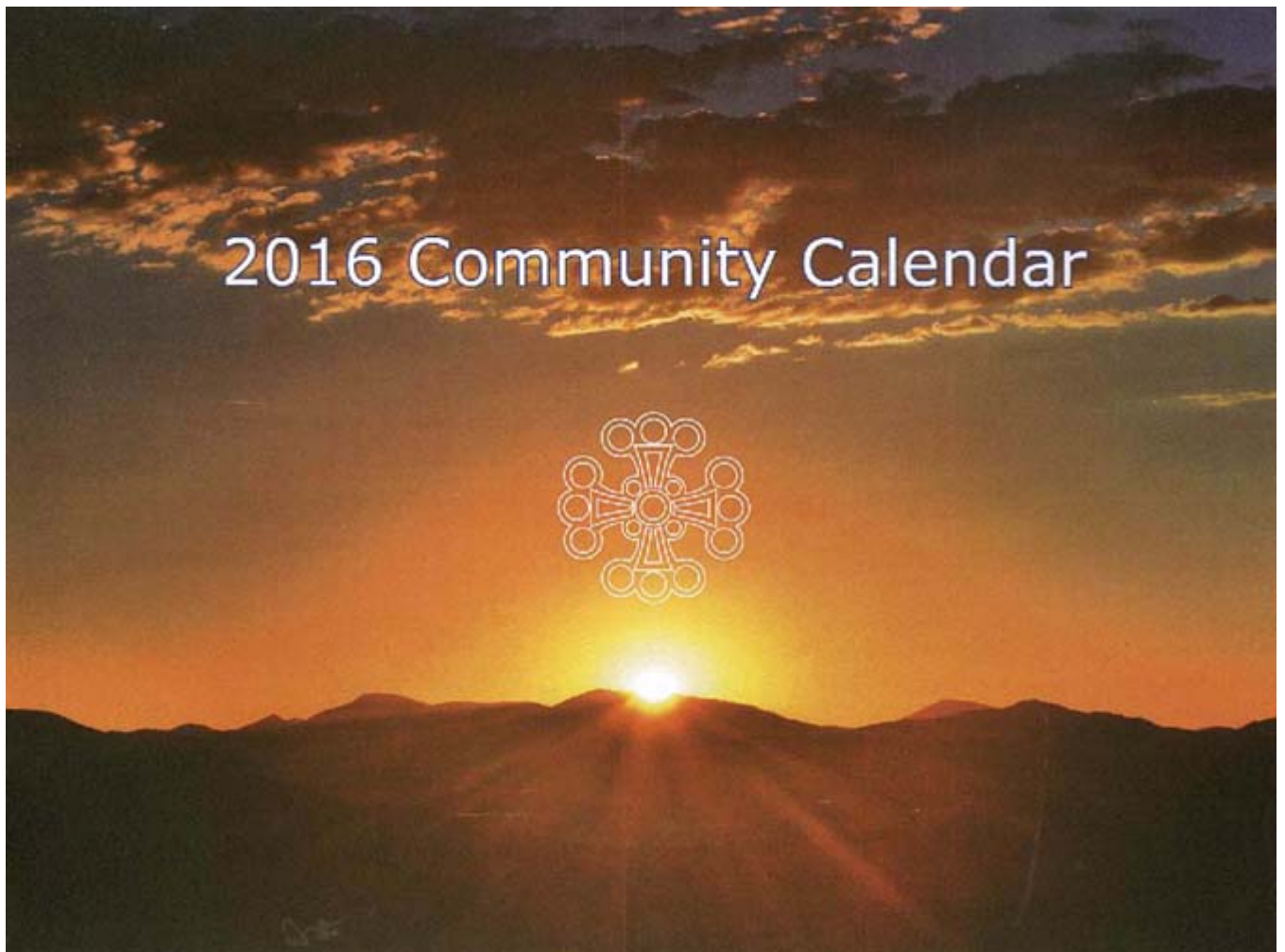

Suddenly they realized that this frenzied running was only making matters worse. Then they stopped and stood perfectly still. As they did, a strange thought flashed across Savoy's mind.

God is in the jungle. It is God's house. Gene had been introduced to the beauties of nature when he was a boy in Oregon. His parents taught him that God had created the universe, sustains it, and resides in it. Why had he closed his eyes to God's presence in the jungles of Peru? Didn't God create them, also? Doesn't God sustain them, also? Doesn't God reside in them, also?

Instantly, Gene relaxed and put all his trust in God, in whose house he was. He said later, "I looked up into the beautiful emerald world of wild orchids, and fragrant blossoms where hummingbirds hovered. Yes, God was here, too. My heart quieted."

At that moment, something deep down within Gene seemed to say, "Walk a few paces to the left." He did. And there was the tiny trail! Gene said later, "I am proud of my archaeological discoveries. But my greatest discovery, I believe, was in recognizing God's presence everywhere."

As a special gift for this time of year, the Church has sent out to all active Community members the Community Calendar for 2016.

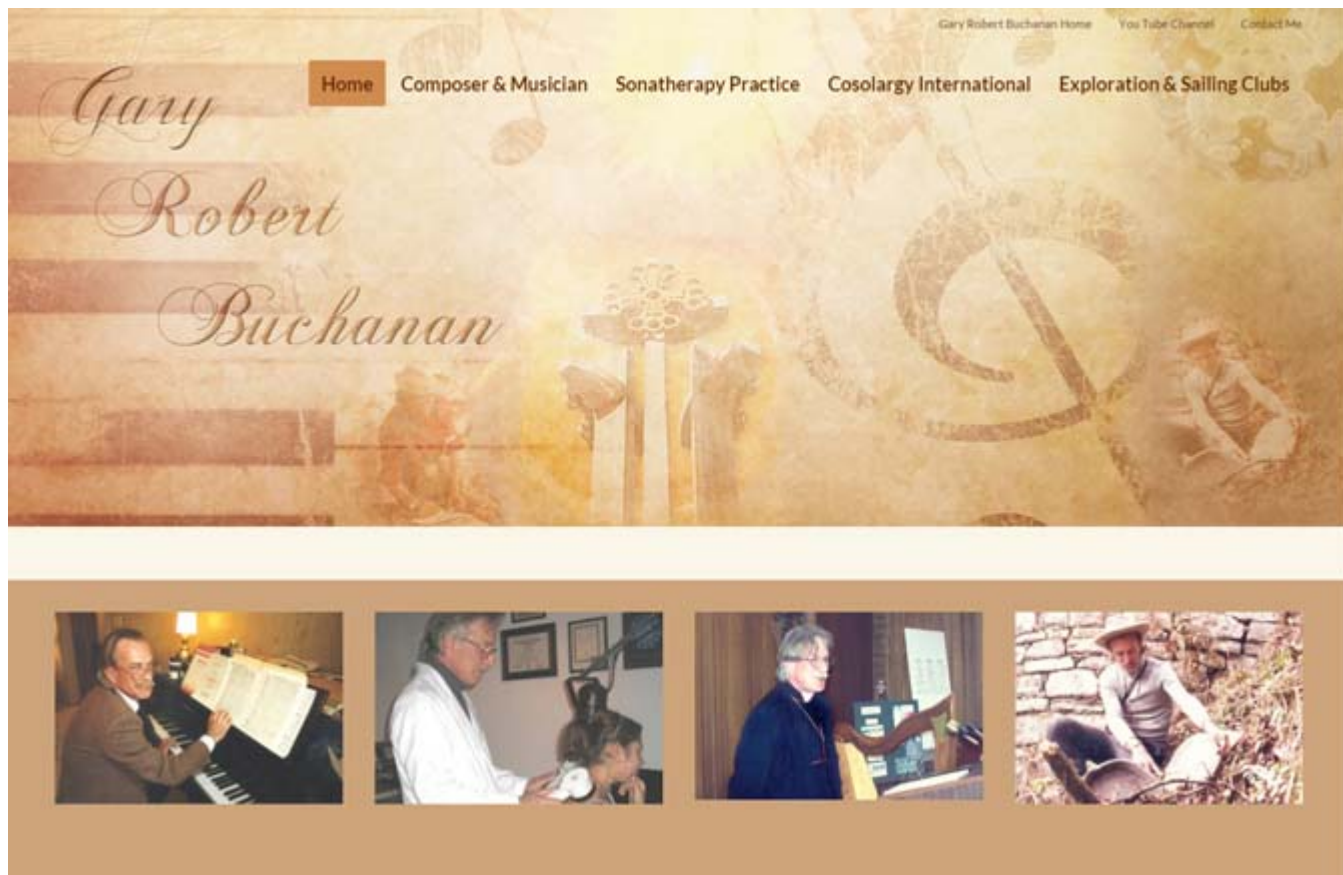

Bishop Gene Invited to 2015 Parliament of the World's

Bishop Gene Savoy Jr. has been invited to be part of the 2015 Parliament of the World's Religions to be held October 15-19, 20125 in Salt Lake City, Utah.

The theme of the 2015 Parliament is Reclaiming the Heart of Our Humanity: Working Tgether for a World of Compassion, Peace, Justice, and Sustainability. The discussion at the Parliament in 2015 will focus on climate change, violence, and wasteful consumption.

Bishop Gene has been invited to speak on the topic "Pathways to Peace: Different Perspectives" as part of the panel organized by Balwant S. Hansra, a Sikh leader and a former member of the Parliament Board. The invitation to speak was accepted by Bishop Gene with these words: "Yes, of course I am very interested in being on your panel. My religion (which is not restricted to Christianity) has a very unique perspective on what the path to peace is. We teach a very specialized practice using natural and cosmic energies by which any

individual, regardless of culture, race or tradition may employ. By so doing, the individual harmonizes him/herself with natural and supranatural energies of the universe. In this way, that person becomes an awakened spiritual Being on Earth, as well as in Heaven. I would very much like to discuss this within the guidelines you lay out.”

The guiding principles of the Parliament of the World’s Religions are respectful dialogue, non-proselytizing, and willingness to explore a wide variety of topics.
