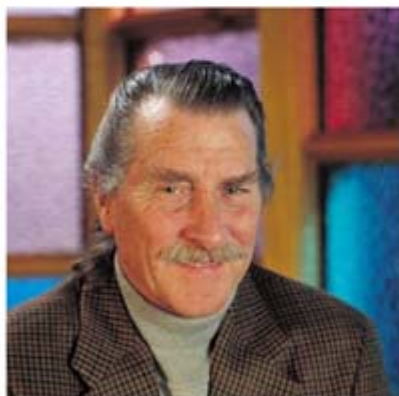

Diaries of the Explorations & Discoveries of Gene Savoy, Sr.

"By tracing stone roads, the explorers traveled north, emerging in Chachapoyas country. The well-trained team crossed the snow-capped peaks of the high Andes, the longest chain of snow-peaks in the world, and cut their way by machete into the thick, streaming jungles called the Montana, where the highest forests on earth grow at sixteen thousand feet above sea level.

"The expedition met with immediate success. It uncovered the first of numerous cities to be reclaimed from the high jungles of Chachapoyas country. Named Gran Pajaten by the explorers, this first ruin was to become an internationally known site. The uncovered Chacha cities were built of white limestone and, for the most part, were composed of round or circular structures. Gran Pajaten was a small temple layout built atop a high promontory overlooking a river. The walls of the structures were decorated with ornamental designs, including human, bird-like figures with wings and crowns. Stone heads were tenoned into the walls. (The decorative motif was similar in many ways to the designs of the Mayan people found on ruins in Mexico and Meso-America.) One such carving represented a great dignitary; it had a foliated nose and bore a crown portraying the unmistakable symbol of Quetzalcoatl, two angular spirals. The tombs of the site, which boasted wood carvings, were located later by helicopter. Years later, archaeologists followed in the explorers' footsteps and examined the site. During a period spanning two decades, Savoy's team reclaimed vast cities from the jungles - some 42 in total. The last to be discovered was explored in 1985 and named Gran Vilaya. (Savoy believes this metropolis to be the largest pre-Columbian city uncovered in the Americas. It is estimated that the city, which boasts 24,000 buildings or more, covers an area of about 100 square miles.)"

A Diary of the Origins of Cosolargy

Cosolargy's calendar marks the first arrival of its founder, Gene Savoy, Sr. in Peru on 14 April 1957. As an explorer, Savoy would go on to earn fame for his discoveries of Vilcabamba, Gran Pajatén, Gran Vilaya, Gran Saposoa, and forty other lost cities – not to mention his remarkable sea voyages on the *Feathered*

Serpent I, II and III – however, his initial archaeological mission to Peru in 1957 was far from plain sailing. The expedition was canceled for lack of financing, but he decided to stay on there for a while.

During the previous year (1956) Savoy's life had changed utterly. His business collapsed and took with it his home, his belongings, and his marriage. Fortuitously, his documentary film of Columbia River Gorge petroglyphs and carvings was picked up by a national news service, and his theories about similarities between North and South American picture drawings attracted the attention of an American archaeologist, who offered to take Savoy on an expedition to Peru as a photographer.

Eager to fulfill his dream of becoming an explorer, Savoy accepted and embarked on his adventure in early 1957. Thus began what would endure as a lifetime connection with Peru. A few years later he began to organize his own archaeological expeditions under the auspices of the Andean Explorers Club, which he founded and is now Gene Savoy Explorations under the auspices of Cosolargy International.

Gene Savoy wrote a number of books about his archaeological expeditions, including *Antisuyo: The Search for the Lost Cities of the Amazon* (1970), *Vilcabamba: Last City of the Incas* (1970), *On the Trail of the Feathered Serpent* (1974), and *Project X: The Search for the Secrets of Immortality* (1977). Noted for his larger-than-life persona, he was dubbed "the real Indiana Jones" by *People* magazine.

Vilcabamba

Throughout the latter half of the 20th century, Gene Savoy made a series of expeditions to Peru, discovering various Inca and pre-Inca archaeological sites. In 1964 he discovered Vilcabamba, the secret

mountain stronghold where the Incas hid from Spanish conquerors in the 16th century. His discovery disproved Bingham's notion that Vilcabamba and Machu Picchu were the same place. (From: Encyclopaedia Britannica).

In 1911, Hiram Bingham, a Yale University professor of history, went to Peru looking for the refuge city of the last Inca, Manco II, who had revolted against the Spaniards following the conquest of Peru under the leadership of Francisco Pizarro. Bingham claimed the lost city to be Machu-Picchu (now a world-famous tourist attraction.) However, Gene Savoy's research indicated that this was not the lost, last city of the Incas. Historical texts and reports by the Spanish soldiers, who eventually tracked down and captured the last of the Incas in refuge, pointed out that the city used by the Incas as a last refuge was located in a region called Vilcabamba, in the far reaches of Antisuyo - the name for that portion of the jungle.

Machu Picchu was neither large enough to be the capital city of the Neo-Inca empire in hiding, nor was it located in the jungle. Savoy's team of explorers would penetrate further into the jungle. After some 90 days of search, they succeeded in locating the real lost city, Vilcabamba - a city complex comprised of about 400 buildings situated over an area of one square mile.

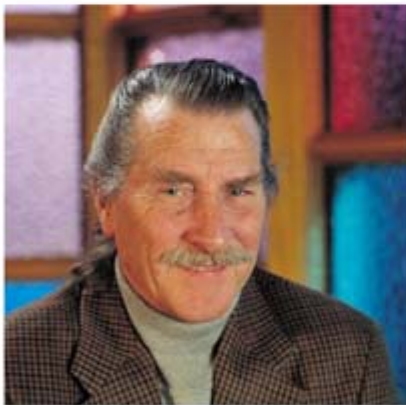

Back in 1947, when Gene Savoy Sr. was a university student preparing for a religious vocation, he was privileged to receive private tutoring from a Monsignor of the Catholic Church, Father John B. Delaunay, Jesuit priest and distinguished psychologist.

Father Delaunay encouraged Savoy to continue his private studies, because something in his writings fascinated him. He said that though Teilhard de Chardin's writings went against orthodoxy, that did not mean that all priests agreed with the Vatican decision affecting them.

At this time Delaunay told Savoy of the underground Charismatic Church at work. He called it the "invisible Church of Christ laboring in the world." The priest explained that this unorganized Church had been a work for some time and would one day bring changes not only upon the Church, but to Christianity and religion as a whole. He felt that this was where Savoy was destined to work, not in the priesthood of the organized Church.

More and more Savoy shared his thoughts and ideas with the sympathetic priests, learned in Sacred Theology and Canon Law, who listened to his opinions on theological concepts of Teilhard's faith, that portion known in those early days dealing with the future evolution of man. Young Savoy spoke of a spiritual world beyond the physical one, a world of unseen forces and invisible energies that emanate from within the Godhead. It seemed likely to him, he would say, that God was separate from the material world, and only the human spirit and soul were part of that spiritual world.

An extract from the book, *The Emerging New Christianity and the Secret Church at Work*, © 1975 by the International Community of Christ.

In 1972 a Community was established in the High Sierra country of Nevada, which in some ways resembled the highlands of

the Andean plateaus [in Peru] from which they had come. Under the direction of Gene Savoy and important members of the original community, a publishing program was inaugurated. The first three years were devoted to compiling the many manuscripts taken from the Peruvian archives into text material so they could be disseminated to students of the System. This material had been gathered over a period of fifteen years and was safely taken out of Peru. During all the years of exploration, carvings, sculptures, and, tablets—among other artifacts—bearing glyphs and signs were carefully recorded and the information translated into a series of remarkable texts.

Two codices, published by the Community, were made available to the public. *The Decoded New Testament* explains the origins of the New Testament, clarifies the ambiguities caused by the loss of the Gospel, the secret System of spiritual regeneration taught by Jesus and the disciples, and shows the function and the universality of the Christ force in the history of the world. *Jamil: Child of Light* tells the story of events that preceded the Child's birth, His life, and revelations for a new way of life for all people in the coming age. Twenty-four other texts were also compiled for distribution to those enrolled in the Academy and the Sacred College.

Project X - The Search for the Secrets of Immortality – The Explorations

In the same year he discovered the Essene literature, Savoy began studies under an Arabian mystic, an associate of the Lebanese poet Kahlil Gibran. Unbeknown to the average reader of Gibran's poetic mysticism, the writer wove into his

works a hidden symbology. He used the same cryptic style employed by the old writers of scripture, of both the Old and the New Testaments. Savoy read into the beautiful lines of the late poet ideas that tantalized him. Beyond a doubt, Gibran had a deep knowledge of transcendental Christianity that had caused him to break from traditional teachings; as a result, the Coptic Church had excommunicated him. Savoy was driven to discover what this knowledge was. From discussions with intimates of Gibran he learned that the poet had believed himself to have been a disciple under Jesus; the latter, Gibran admitted, had appeared to him three times in his present life. The poet had confessed to Barbara Young, his secretary and associate, that he had been Judas, now returned to atone for his betrayal of the master. This atonement consisted of leaving behind a testimonial through his work. One day he was observed looking at the sun with eyes made for its bright rays. The secretary, who had seen him, was attracted to the brilliant light radiating about his person. When she inquired about it, he refused to discuss the matter and asked her to say nothing to anyone. As was customary concerning his private life, Gibran swore her to secrecy regarding this incident and the previous confession.

From 1957 until 1971 Gene Savoy, in company with members of the school, conducted a grand exploration program of the Andes and the Amazonian jungles in Peru, Ecuador, Colombia, and Brazil. It was during this time that many ancient cities and temple sites were recovered from the mantle of growth that had covered them for centuries. These exploits were recorded in *Antisuyo—The Search for the Lost Cities of the Amazon* (New York: Simon & Schuster, 1970); *Vilcabamba—The Lost Cities of the Incas* (London: Robert Hale, 1970); *On the Trail of the Feathered Serpent* (New York: Bobbs-Merrill, 1974), all authored by Gene Savoy. CBS News recorded his explorations in a one-hour documentary, and the major magazines and newspapers of the world reported the remarkable findings. Other manuscripts covering this period are

presently in press, having been withheld from publication. The published stories were restricted to the archeological, anthropological, and historical significance of the expeditions. No mention was ever made of the Community's inner work, because the reporters were never informed of it.
