Gary Buchanan Speaking at International Water Conference



Reverend Canon Gary Buchanan will be in Sofia, Bulgaria October 6-9, 2016 to speak at the 11th Annual Water Conference. He will be speaking along with Dr. Gerald Pollack, an old colleague of his who has gained fame in recent years for his theory of fourth-phase water, and who is chairing the conference, and along with several Nobel Prize laureates. Rev. Buchanan's work on Sonotherapy and his use of water to form archetypal cymographs made him a candidate for speaking at this prestigious international conference. 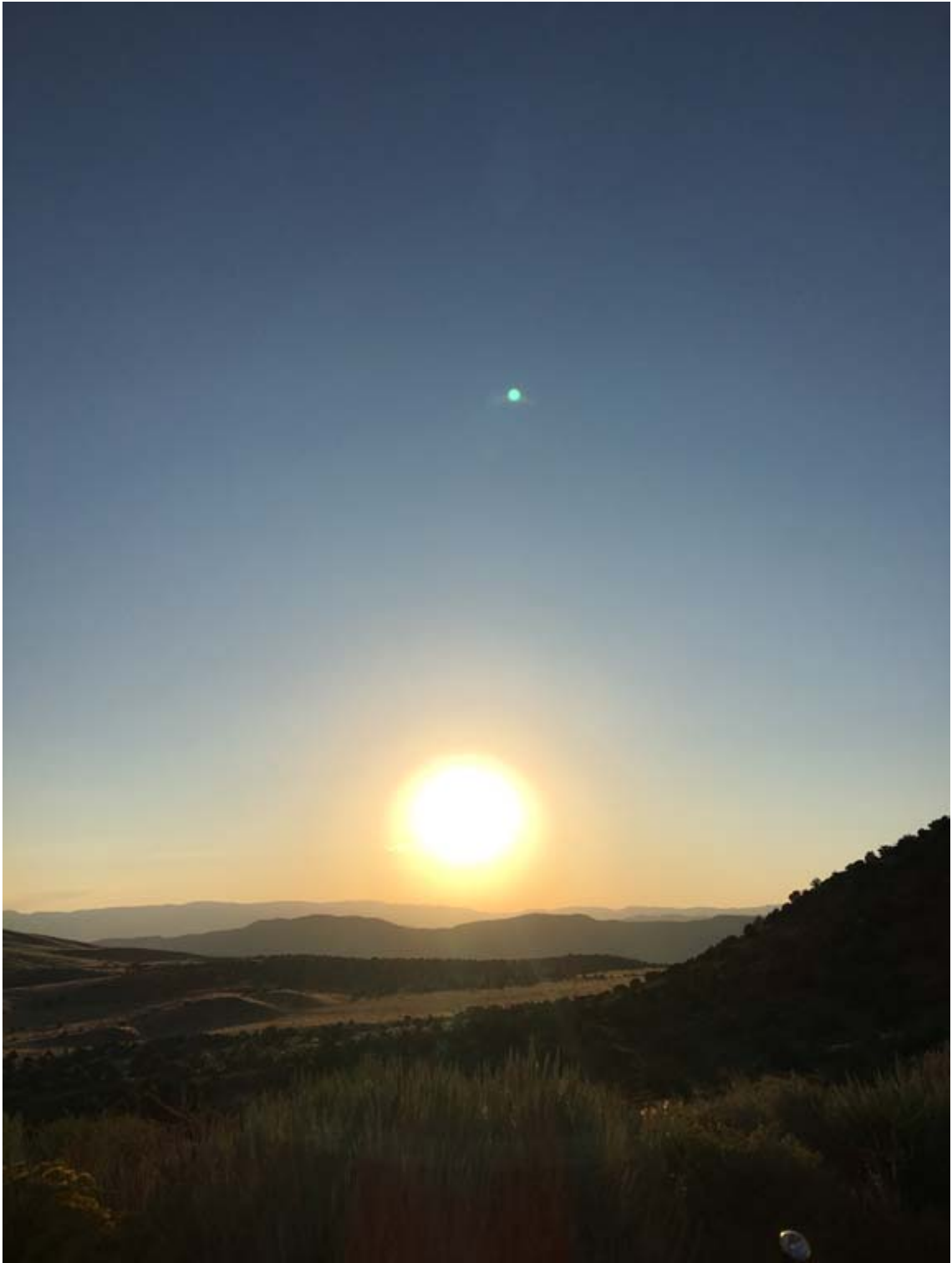

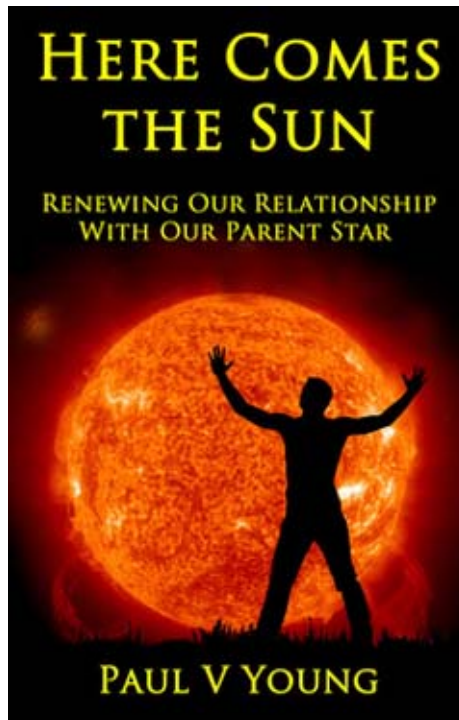
