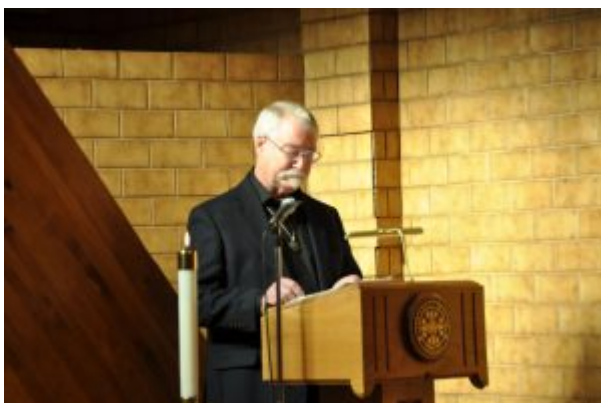

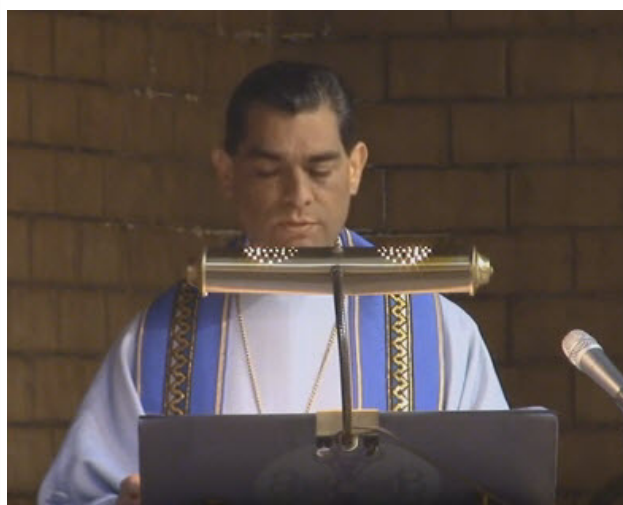

Quotes from Gene Savoy, Sr.

"The Man [Gene Savoy, Sr.] bent down to take the boy into his arms. And Jamil+ extended his glorified hand to touch his father. And he wiped away his tears with a kiss. Then he stood up and looked deep into the older man's eyes, and The Light+ flashed again. And he spoke to the inner ear of The Man's Eternal Soul+, saying: "Weep not, father, for I shall not pass until the allotted time. If you would mourn, mourn for those poor, suffering souls here. For I say unto you that the mountain

shall fall again in the space of time, long after the memory of what has occurred here has faded from their minds. Nothing shall remain of this city, save the covered remains of the dead and their habitations.

"And men in the four quarters of the world shall weep for these souls, unaware that the dead will be witness to that which is destined for the whole world. And you shall see in time to come that this shall be the beginning of sorrows spoken of by former Prophets inspired by God the Father+. The human family has turned from God+ and trusted in worldly ways, spurred on by the physical sciences that deny that man is the bearer of the human spirit. Some would have the children of God+ believe that man has no purpose, that his identity and self-hood is destroyed with the loss of the physical body. 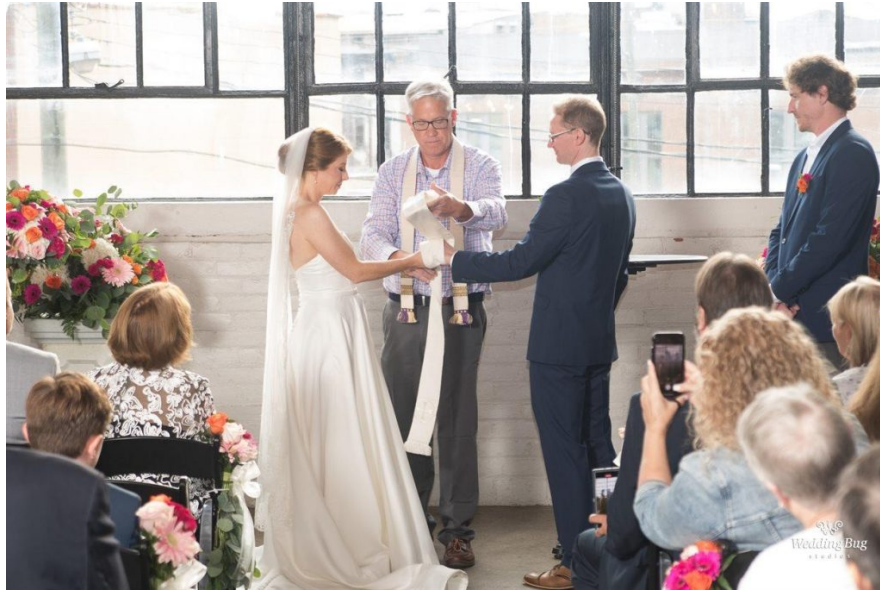

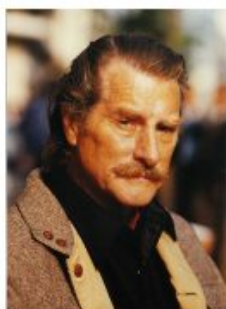

"As light gave way to darkness, terror-stricken survivors who had sought safety on the summits filtered into the community to tell of the dreadful occurrence. When the landslide struck, the sun was darkened and the moon shed no light. The earth trembled in anger, and many feared the mighty Huascarán would fall again. It was a terrifying night. And at daybreak, though no eye saw the sun rise from behind the mountains, they awoke from their slumber. And a great multitude congregated and walked to the edge of the flow—with stunned faces, they gazed upon the desolation.

"The once happy community of Ranrahirca and its inhabitants lay beneath the earth. All was gone, save the mud and the rock and the ice. And the village elders wondered what they should do. Many swore at the mountain, shaking their fists in the direction of the citadel covered by clouds and mist. Others buried their heads in their chests and walked away knowing that the life they had known was gone forever. Not a few of the younger men accused God+ of having no mercy, and they turned away from the pitiless firmament, bitter of heart; for they felt the people had suffered enough over the centuries."

Rev. Jo Ann Hainline Passes into the Light



The Reverend Jo Ann Hainline, born into this world on November 7, 1949, in Davenport, Iowa, passed into the Light on September 17, 2023 in Reno, Nevada.

Jo Ann graduated from North Miami High School in Miami-Dade, Florida, which she attended because of national level swimming competitions. At one time she held the women's national record

for the 400 meter individual medley, one of the toughest swimming events.

Later, in Des Moines, Iowa, Jo Ann attended Augustana College and the University of Iowa. She first contacted the International Community of Christ/Cosolargy in June of 1975. Inspired by many mystical experiences, she enrolled in The Academy.

By April 1976, she became a member of the Order of Monk de Jure of the Rectory Abbey, an Order which played a major role in sponsoring the publication of *The Secret Sayings of Jamil* codices of *The Sacred Teachings of Light*.

In February of 1977, Jo Ann became a member of The Ship's Company of the Feathered Serpent II, with her contribution toward the purchase of the ship, a stay sail schooner which sailed as The Community's second Ship of Light. The Ship of Light – Feathered Serpent II – voyaged during a time of both religious inspiration and spiritual prophecy for The Church from 1977 to 1980.

In May of 1978, Jo Ann made the decision to move to Reno, Nevada and become a resident member of The Community, bringing her two children, Michael Shane and Erica Jalayne. Shane and Jalayne became among the first students of The Community's Jamilian Parochial School. Jalayne was in the first graduating class.

Jo Ann enrolled in the Sacred College of Jamilian Theology, receiving first level ordination on July 22, 1978. In March 1979, she entered The Academy's First Clergy Program continuing through Liturgy III.



After settling in Reno, Jo Ann met the Reverend Bruce Kanzelmeyer, also a member of The Community. They married in October of 1986 and soon, thereafter, were blessed with two sons, Jonathan Christopher and Gabriel James.

Jo Ann received second level ordination in 1994 and was given a Special Assignment as Deacon-Overseer of the Sanctuary at the Red Rock Consecrated Sanctuary. In 2007, she was ordained at to third level as Presbyter-Overseer of the Sanctuary with the title of Reverend.

Jo Ann was the mother of four children and loved teaching. She was a Montessori-trained and credentialed teacher, teaching in Iowa and then in Reno. The love of teaching the whole child was the core of all her work as a parent, teacher and counselor/therapist. In 1993, Jo Ann received her Bachelor of Arts Degree from the University of Nevada, Reno (UNR) in General Studies, and then her Nevada Elementary Teacher's Credential in 1994.

Jo Ann received her Master's Degree in Counseling and

Educational Psychology from UNR in 1998, specializing in Marriage and Family Therapy (MFT) and School Counseling. In 2002, she received her Nevada State MFT License. She transitioned to teaching in the Washoe County School District in 1998 and then, in 2015, she became an elementary school counselor, until she retired in 2020.

In 2003, Jo Ann began working evenings and weekends for several agencies as an MFT, working with parents and children, and facilitating domestic violence and parenting classes. She opened a private practice – Insight Therapies – in 2013, where she specialized in working with foster and adopted children and blended families. Jo Ann continued counseling until her last day with us.

Jo Ann was profoundly devoted to The Community, Cosolargy and The Teachings of Light and a fierce defender of the Truth within the Sun of Righteousness. Bishop Gene Savoy, Jr. and officials of the Church performed the Anointing of the Remains of the Deceased prior to cremation in company with members of Jo Ann's family on Wednesday, September 20, 2023. A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, December 9, 2023 in the Chapel of the Holy Child.

**Second Advent Pentecost
Observation, June 6 2023**



Second Advent Pentecost (June 6, 2023)

On Sunday, June 6, 2023, the Second Advent Pentecost Sunrise Divine Service planned at the Church of New Pentecost was moved to the End Times Parsonage due to rain. Breakfast was served at the parsonage, after which very special ordinations were held for new members of the orders of Patriarchs and Matriarchs ([click here](#) to read the post on the ordinations). Details and photos of the ordinations can be found in a separate article.

Pentecost in the Second Advent Church signifies that God has bestowed His Divine Presence upon The Community in Sanctuary – The Image and The Word that nurture the spirit and Soul with Life and Wisdom. The old First Dispensation Christian celebration commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Disciples seven weeks after the resurrection of Jesus. In the old Hebrew calendar, Pentecost – Shavuot or the Festival of Weeks – commemorated the giving of the Law on Mount Sinai. For the Essaei Community, the Festival of Weeks was the time to renew one's vows and to review one's place in the Order. In the Second Advent, New Laws were revealed at the Temple Mount for a New Age under God at the Second Coming. And this is the

purpose of celebrating the date of June 6th in the Sacred Calendar of The Community.
