Quotes from Gene Savoy, Sr.

The Synoptic Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke disagree on the teachings and purpose of the ministry of Jesus. Some say that he established a new religion based on his person. Others claim that his religion was a matter of having faith in the Fatherhood of God. Still others say that it revolved around the concept of the coming Kingdom of God. There was much conflict in the Church then, and there still is now.

The original teachings of Jesus were whole and dynamic. He taught a system that could bring about not only the transformation of the individual into a spiritual being of Light, but also the transformation of the world into a world of Light, and the establishment of God's Kingdom on earth. This was his goal as Messiah, just as it had been the hope of the sect that bred him in the wilderness.

Jesus was not a simple man who suddenly proclaimed himself to be the Messiah and then faded away. He was a man of considerable knowledge, a Master teacher of an established sect that went beyond the Judaism of the Pharisees and the Sadducees. Had his teachings and secret doctrines survived to the present day, their impact upon human thought would have altered the course of human events, and the world might indeed be a different place than it is.
