Higher Centers

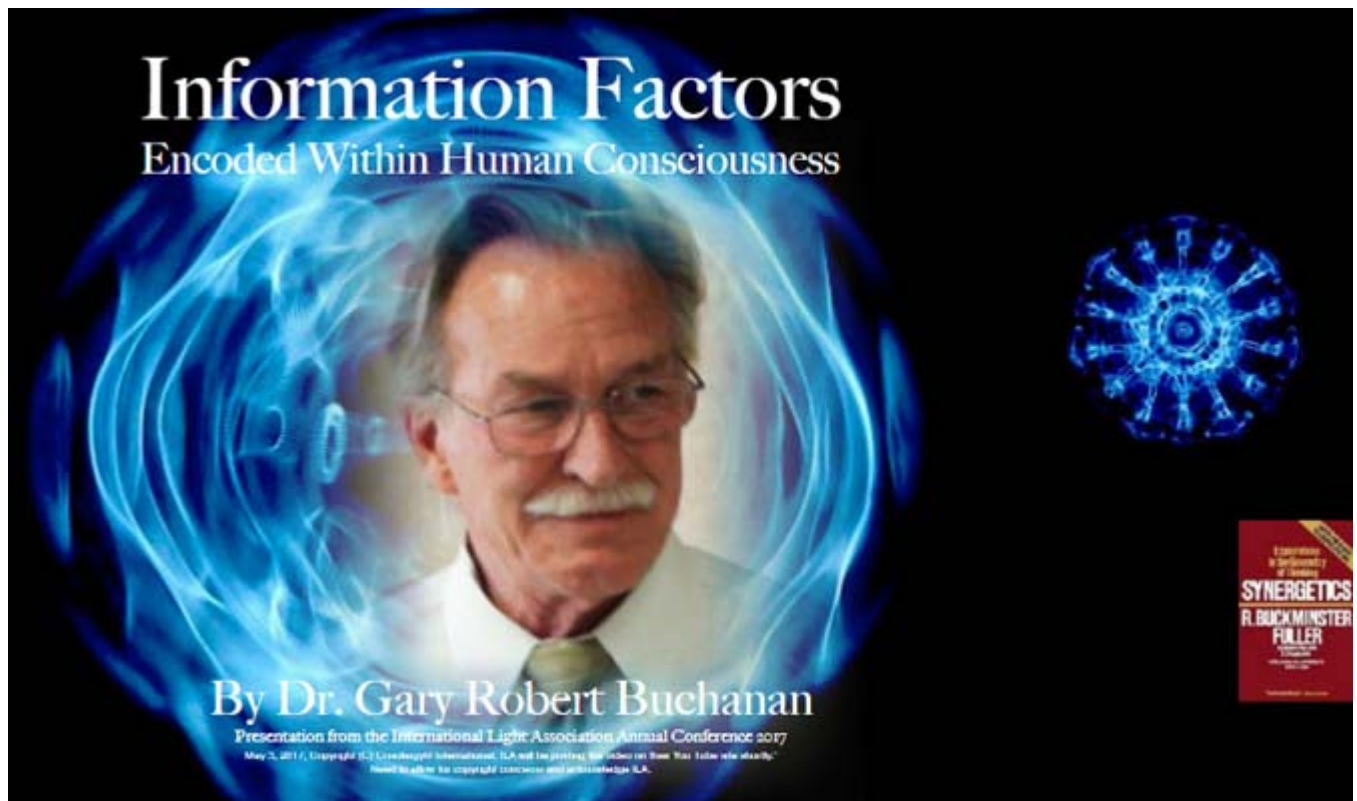
“While Mr. Atkinson says this “light” that makes us believe in

"The famous Pythagorean Y signified the power of choice and was used in the Mysteries as emblematic of the Forking of the Ways. “When spiritual leaders like Boehme speak of a new birth, or rebirth, they are not talking about reincarnation. They are talking about a spiritual birth of sorts. Since the spirit and soul are immortal, they are not truly born, or reborn. They are simply awakened from a deep coma-like state that is similar to death. So when those spiritual faculties are awakened, it is often referred to as a New Birth or Rebirth.

“Boehme says this new birth is necessary to be a temple of God, and he is correct. Foolish people think they can be a temple of God no matter what they do, what they say, or what they think. Nonsense. God will not dwell in the physical body or in the brain-mind. He dwells only in the spirit and soul. Therefore, the only way to know God, and be one with God, is to awaken those spiritual faculties and use them.”

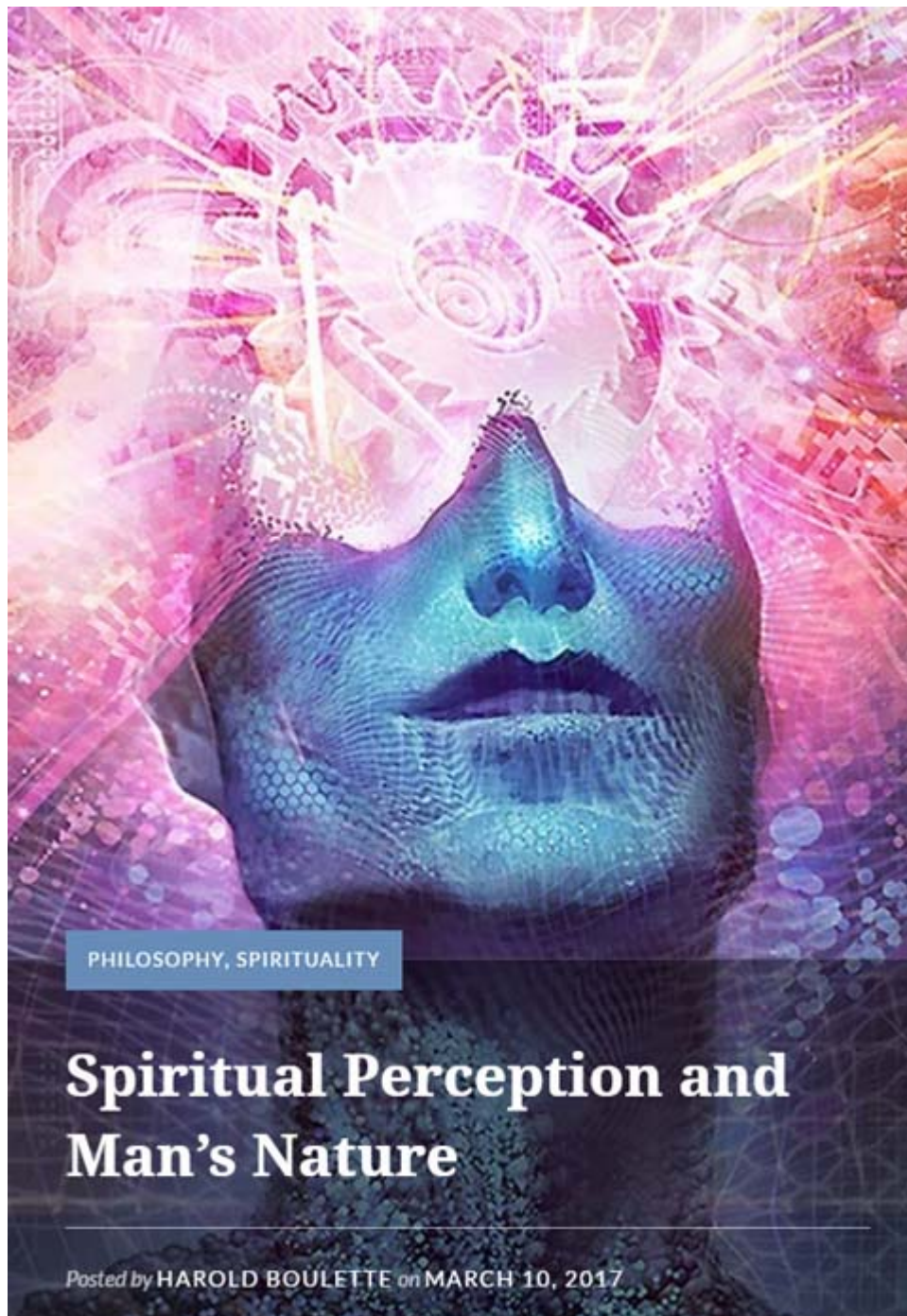

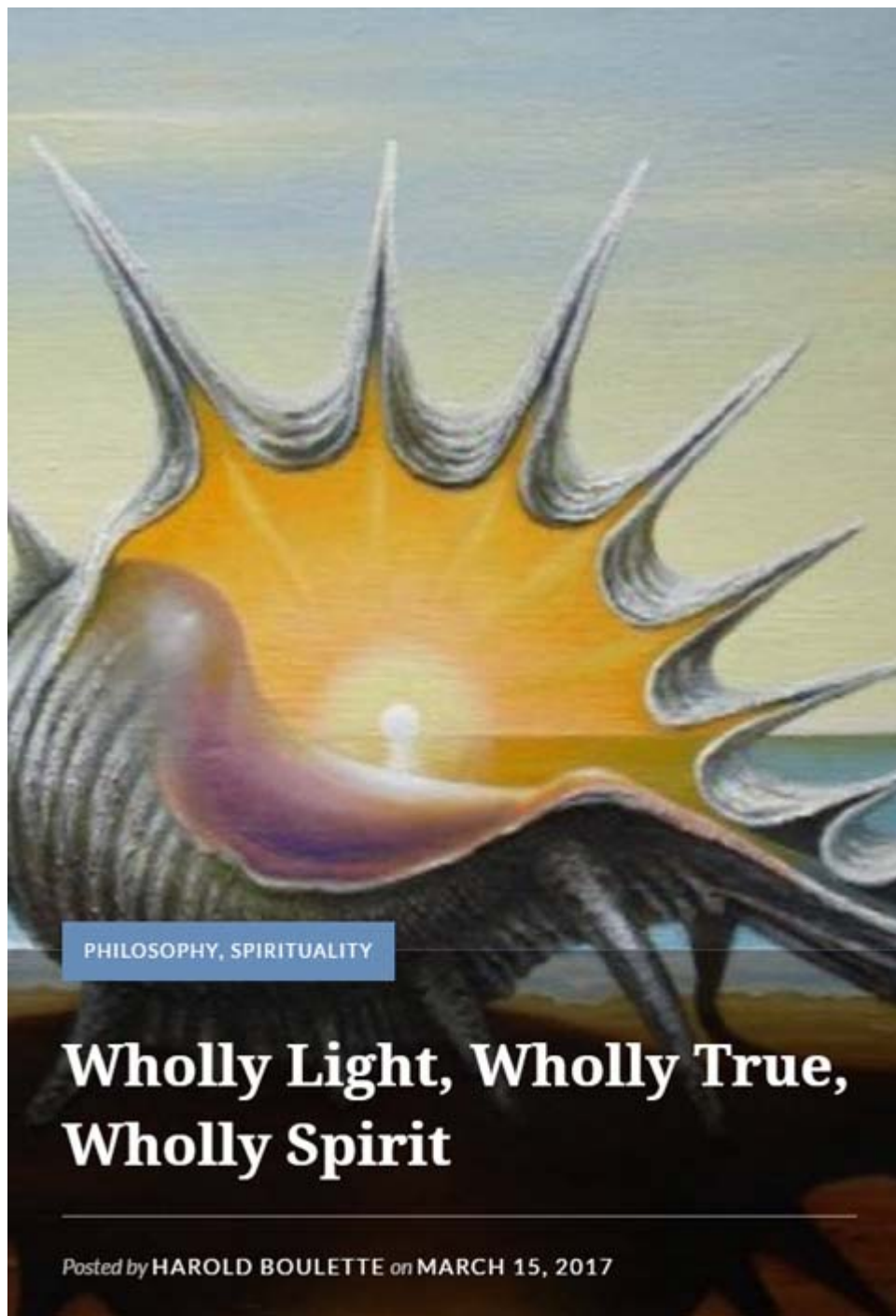
Man's Nature
