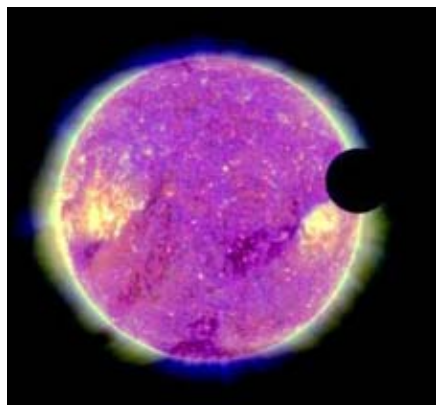


“Electric Moon Jolts the Solar Wind”

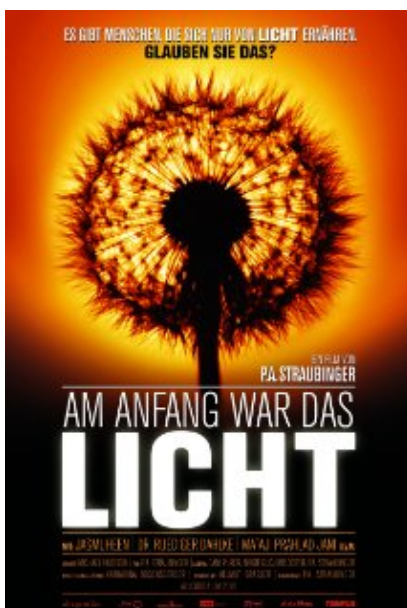

Swiss Woman Dies After Attempting to Live on Sunlight

Tages-Anzeiger reported on April 25, 2012, that a woman in the Austrian town of Wolfhalden had starved to death after embarking on a "spiritual diet" that required her to stop eating or drinking and to live off sunlight alone.

The Zurich newspaper reported that the unnamed Swiss woman, who was in her fifties, decided to follow the radical fast in 2010 after viewing the Austrian film documentary *In the Beginning There Was Light* (2010) by director P. A. Straubinger on the subject of people who attempt to nourish themselves exclusively on light.

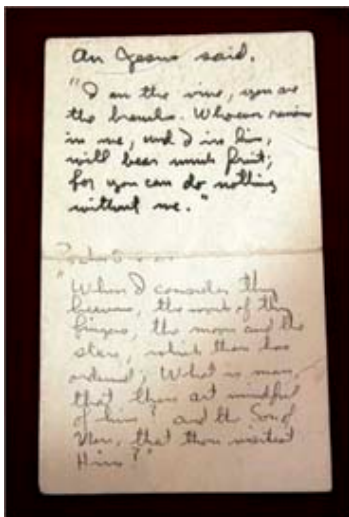

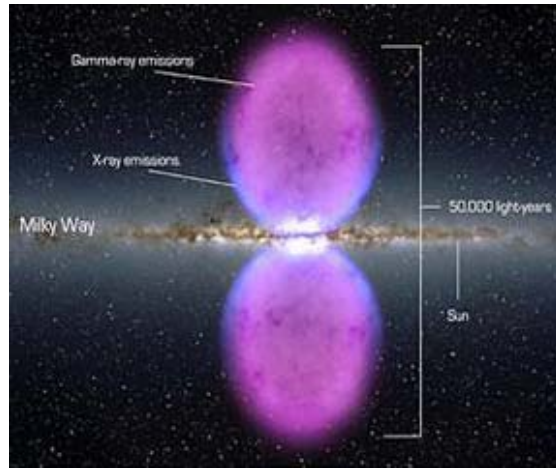
Communion on the Moon July 20, 1969

“Mysterious Objects at the Edge of the Electromagnetic Spectrum”

"NASA has many telescopes 'working the wavelengths' up and down the electromagnetic spectrum. One of them, the Fermi Gamma-Ray Telescope orbiting Earth, has just crossed a new electromagnetic frontier.

"'Fermi is picking up crazy-energetic photons,' says Dave Thompson, an astrophysicist at NASA's Goddard Space Flight Center. 'And it's detecting so many of them we've been able to produce the first all-sky map of the very high energy universe.'"

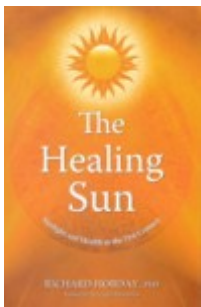
Communiqué readers may find this article interesting within the context of higher sources of energy and higher manifestations of energy, concepts which science is just now acknowledging.

Can Sungazers Obtain Limitless Human Potential?

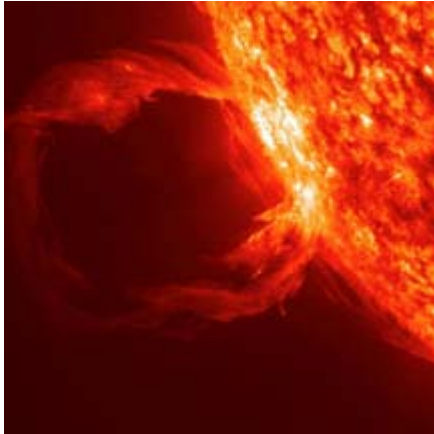

And he is taking notes to see whether it happens again. People have had the same symptoms, he says, before mid to large earthquakes.

Dr. Lee notes, “The point/theme of the article is to keep a positive mental attitude during these symptoms, which is a good idea with or without solar flares. The Half Past Human / WebBot project warned about the ‘sun disease,’ which seems to correlate with some Mayan prophecies.”

Vatican Interested in CERN Findings on “God Particle”
