JUST OFF THE PRESS. *First Prophecy to the Americas*, in the series: *The Prophecies of Janil*, is now off the press. Dear Associates:

Symposiums I, II & III have been well received and old Associates from earlier days who corresponded with the Mystery School of the Andes in Peru have been able to participate in oral instruction and meet with personnel.

Those who have joined the school in the last three years and who are restricted to correspondence have realized immense benefit from the personal contact. Each seminar consists of about 12 hours of oral instruction over a three-day period.

The sound department has acquired a Telex cassette duplicator and professional recording equipment. Copies of the three seminars will be available by the middle of the month on 60-minute cassette tapes of excellent quality.

Transcripts of the Seminars which are word-for-word copies of the tapes, including diagrams, are being printed. These scripts are averaging 100 to 150 pages in length in clear, easy-to-read Gothic type. We found the transcripts a little bit more than we bargained for and just as difficult to prepare for the text as book-length volumes which resulted in a 6-week delay on Seminar I. Each script is bound with a durable, black plastic cover. These transcripts are excellent quality, exciting reading and most instructive.

TAPE AND TRANSCRIPTS BRING THE SEMINARS right into the privacy of one's home. They eliminate the expense of travel and time, and many are taking advantage of this savings. It also permits those who may only be able to participate in a select number of Seminars to learn from the entire program. Those not familiar with the cassette program are urged to obtain a tape player. The tapes are helpful in getting the most out of the voice instruction.

The Community's new advertising program which may be followed in the February issue of PSYCHOLOGY TODAY is to be continued on a monthly basis. The 1/3 page vertical insertion advertises THE RECORDED NEW TESTAMENT. Ad copy will also appear in the March issue of THE ATLANTIC MONTHLY and the April issue of HARPERS MAGAZINE. THE SATURDAY REVIEW is running a special story on psychic phenomena in the February 22nd issue and our advertisement will be run in that edition. Associates can expect to see the Community's programs listed in the leading national magazines from now on.

A NEW MOTION PICTURE DEPARTMENT is currently being organized by the Community. Several scripts are under consideration and films will be made by members of the Community in collaboration with artists, directors and technicians friendly with the Community. Copies of the films will be made available to Overseers for showing in their respective communities when completed.

LAST MONTH'S EARTHQUAKE in Peru was stronger and of longer duration than the May 1970 quake that took the lives of nearly 70,000 Indians and completely destroyed Tugay, the little highland village where the Child Christ spent his last days. The large statue of Jesus erected following the catastrophe still stands at the cemetery, as does the Child's secret tomb. The Child predicted that Peru would be the scene of many disasters and that the whole world could learn of its own destiny by observing what takes place there.

Desert Seminars are being held in Reno during the week of 15, 16, 17 of October and during the weekend of 25, 26, 27 of October. For information telephone Rev. Loren Lewis, 702-786-7827.

Graduates who have completed studies are now eligible for initiation at the Sacred Oversee in Reno. This includes Associates who go back to the Penzance school and all those who have completed at least eighteen months of study. A special letter on this subject is being mailed to those qualified. For further information call the Center.

The Community's Code Book and Manual is currently being prepared for the press. This important volume (Codex III of the Sacred Teachings of Light series) is an integral part of the program and gives greater meaning to the individual's participation in advanced programs.

The Community's Dream and Vision Analysis Handbook has finally been scheduled for publication next March, 1975, following the release of the Code Book mentioned in the above paragraph. Those who have already ordered this volume will be glad to know that the book is to include a large number of archetypal symbols and references.

The economic situation in the United States and other parts of the world dictates that all Associates and Reverends do their very best to tighten budgets and, above all, to find ways of saving money by eliminating unnecessary purchases. Food prices are still below those of other developed countries. By refusing to buy products that are not absolutely needed, by shopping and looking for bargains, savings can be made. A good place to begin is with the businessman. Look for bargains, try to lower the price if you make a cash purchase. Eliminate interest rates on credit cards or charge accounts. By going on cash basis you can insist on 2 percent discount; if not given, shop elsewhere. The secret of lower costs lies with the consumer who must go back to the cost-conscious consumer attitude prevalent in the 1920's and 1930's. Cut buying and costs will automatically lower.

THE AUTOMOBILE HAS BECOME A CONSUMER SPONGE due to high cost of purchase price, interest rates, high insurance, taxes and ever-increasing cost of fuel. License and registration fees as well as police vigilance on the municipal and state level with resulting fines for speeding over the very low speed limit of 55mph make driving a responsibility that some are finding unbearable. The automobile is the major polluter of the atmosphere, yet industry continues to make high horsepower engines that consume large amounts of gasoline with low mileage and dangerous exhaust. Automobiles dominate downtown streets and are a nuisance to pedestrians. Fifty thousand men, women and children are killed each year in automobile accidents. Because of these considerations, the consumer should either cut down on the use of the automobile or, when possible, eliminate it entirely and rely on buses, taxis and other public or collective transportation systems.

CODE BOOK: Once our Associates have received the DECODED NEW TESTAMENT, presently on the press, they will be eligible for the MINISTER'S CODE BOOK which is a guide for the individual considering ordination and pastoring assignment. This volume will immediately follow publication of the DECODED NEW TESTAMENT and is a must for all Associates because it lists our Constitution, Formation Papers, Proclamation of Human Spiritual Rights, Institutes, Precepts, Concepts, Ethics, Codes and other pertinent information. The manual is most important in helping guide the Associate in the ministerial duties within his or her own home or outside it, e.g., proper methods of baptism, marriage, exorcism, funeral rights, etc. Once the individual is ordained as an Overseer in the Community he or she must then decide to what extent each will serve humanity. The Code Book is both a Manual and Guide Book for general ministerial duties covering all situations. Publication date about June 8th, 1974.



INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY OF CHRIST: The Community will henceforth be known under the proper and complete name of International Community of Christ for Advancement in the Religious Arts, Sciences and Technologies of Cosology. Cosology is a universal system of spiritual development which is being brought out of the Christian religion.

Eventually it will be taught internationally (translations of our scripture are presently being undertaken) to different cultures that question the Christian implications. There will be International Communities aimed at Muslims, Buddhists, Hindus, etc. And, while these Communities may be known under different names, Cosology will be the universal word that will bind them.



DESERT RETREAT: We are aware that many Associates cannot afford the time or the financial outlay necessary to make an extended trip abroad to visit pyramids for the purpose of receiving special techniques, which can be beneficial only at the areas in question.

Cosolargy teaches that religion (in the highest sense of the word, which is not to be confused with dogmatic religion), is a vital part of man's inner inclination which cannot be answered by technology as generally understood, viz., empirical scientific technology. Western technology has claimed that religion, in the traditional manner, cannot meet man's needs. While this may be true, technology cannot meet these needs either. In view of this, modern man needs a superior religion that is both scientific and technical while at the same time meeting man's natural inclinations. Science claims that God is dead. If this is taken to be literally true, then man is dead; for man is (we are taught) created in the image of God. Such a teaching, if accepted by educated nations, means that the spirit and the soul is not recognized by technological society. This is the outcome of empirical science and its inquiry into nature at the exclusion of seeking the nature of man. As a consequence, science and technology has gained more knowledge of nature than of man with the result that science and technology has advanced without the knowledge and wisdom necessary to handle that information (old age is nothing more than the inability of the organism to utilize the information locked up in the genes).
