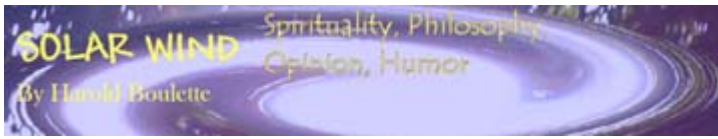


“Esoteric and Spiritual Writings”
