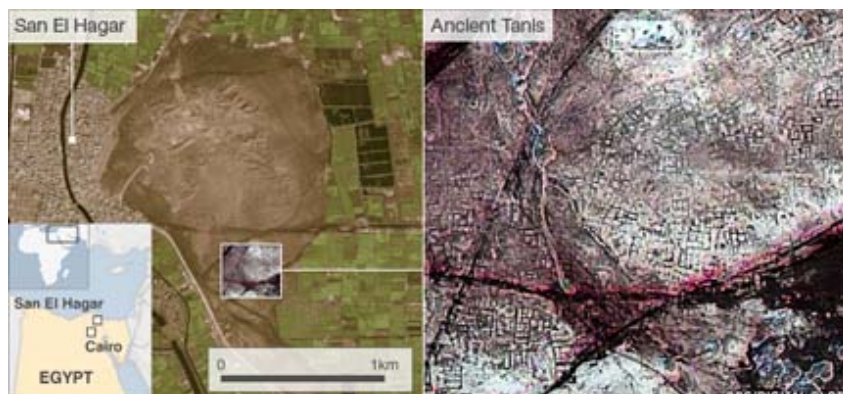


New Pyramid Sites Discovered in Egypt and Sudan
