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CODE BOOK: Once our Associates have received the DECODED NEW TESTAMENT, presently on the press, they will be eligible for the MINISTER'S CODE BOOK which is a guide for the individual considering ordination and pastorship assignment. MUSIC: We are pleased to reproduce the contents of a letter received from one of our Research Associates regarding investigation of the musical scale in relation to personal development.

"Regarding music and Cosolargy, I have had prior experience and study in this field. About 20 years ago, I did some study and played guitar in a small band. I noted then how various aspects of music corresponded to personality types. Some individuals played in *minor* chords, others preferred the *ninth*, or *seventh*, or *sixth*. Music can be arranged to cause any effect desired: sadistic moods, potential to riot, loose morals or, in fact, any center can be affected beyond the person's control if one is unaware of what is going on. Since music can be so devastating, it also can modulate the individual into a higher frequency. In prior cultures, they used music to occupy a given faculty so that a certain harmony would instill harmonics of a higher frequency in the individual. We can see the relationship between music and energy intake when we combine the former with sunviewing techniques. Present experiments show tension if a proper attitude is not maintained. However, the benefits are likely to go unnoticed by the lower faculties, for, while the lower being is occupied, the higher being registers responses to the harmony of the spheres.

"The SEVEN note musical scale corresponds to personal beingness, and the decimal TEN corresponds to impersonal beingness. Expanding upon this point, there are 100 or less elements formed in the 3/D-universe (natural conditions). Physical configurations, operating freely at a higher level, assume 100 or less divisions of manifestation. The X-factor then could be considered one of those frequencies measured only as a 5/D reality.

"I note also that each individual responds to one primary section of a SEVEN divisional life-development process. (Healing profession, the Arts, persons of action, etc.). Each is important in the universal process."
