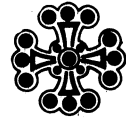

CREW RETURNS--The Feathered Serpent II crew and their captain will be returning to the United States in late November to present the findings of their four-month expedition in Venezuela, and to personally share their experiences with those attending the Community Christmas Week beginning December 27 through January 2, 1978.

MONK DE JURE--Second Annual Meeting to take place in Reno, at the Rectory-Abbey, on December 27 & 28, 1977. This meeting will be highlighted by the reading of the second volume of THE SECRET SAYINGS OF JAMIL. Personal participation in this event is a privilege and an honor that cannot be overemphasized. Creation of the Order of the Holy Child is partly the fulfillment of one of the commands of the Child Christ Jamil.

PROPHECIES OF JAMIL--Reading of the Prophecies of Jamil *To The Races Of Man* will take place in Reno on December 29 & 30, 1977. This will be an opportunity for those members of the Community who feel the need for greater participation and personal commitment to partake of an experience the kind of which had been relegated to 2000 years ago until now.

PROJECT X SEMINAR--To take place in Reno on December 31, 1977 through January 1 & 2, 1978. This seminar will offer a unique opportunity to those who have been applying the techniques of the System to learn more about the teachings of the Community firsthand.

COMMUNION BREAKFAST--Associates attending the Community's Christmas Week will be able to participate in this weekly gathering. Communion Breakfast is held every Saturday at 10:00 (PST) for the purpose of sharing a communal meal in fellowship and thank God for having sent the Sun of Righteousness into the world and to pray that people all over the world may share in similar acts of fellowship with a free spirit and devoid of prejudices. Communion Breakfast will be held on Saturday, December 31st.

SUNRISE SERVICE--Every Sunday, at sunrise, Community members in the Reno area gather at the Rectory-Abbey to commune with the Christ force within the physical sun in fellowship. Each is able to practice their favorite, or scheduled technique for the week after which all partake of an early breakfast together. Associates visiting Reno on January 1, 1978 will be able to participate in this spiritually strengthening event.

RECORDINGS--Recordings of the Prophecies of Jamil and Project X Seminar will be available to those Associates who are not able to attend personally. Cassettes will be rushed by air mail within 3 to 4 days following conclusion of this very special week. Personal participation through attendance is encouraged; however, the recordings should also provide the Associate with a special feeling of Community and spiritual relationship with other members, though some of it will have to be left to the imagination. We suggest the Associate reserve his or her own set of cassettes as early as possible since orders are handled on a first-come-first-serve basis.

PROJECT X--Project X: The Search for the Secrets of Immortality is now available through your local bookstore. With diagrams and photographs, Project X is a personal experience with universal forces, both positive and negative. It proposes new and different concepts of man and his future. Is man going to face the reality of his spiritual and physical extinction? Is man ready to take the path towards his own immortality once again? These and other questions are brought up in this book. Its reading is a must for the Associate. As a Christmas gift to friends and relatives it should be a valuable addition to their libraries.

NEW STAFF MEMBERS AT CENTER Since January, four new staff members have joined us full time at our Administrative Center in Reno. These include:

JOHN MAHAN - Mr. Mahan is from Aloha, Oregon, where he was Assistant Director of the Mentat School and has also held administrative positions with the California Association of Management and the California State Employees Association, and has served as counselor and teacher for the Department of Youth Authority in California. He is a graduate of California State University with post-graduate work in psychology and education. Mr. Mahan has assumed several administrative and legal assignments and is in charge of the Community's long-range plans for a children's school. He is also serving as a crew member on the Feathered Serpent.

ROBERT DE LA CRUZ - Mr. de la Cruz was formerly stationed with the United States Air Force as an ATC operator in Blytheville, Arkansas, and has attended Georgia Tech. He is originally from Cuba and came to the United States in 1962. Mr. de la Cruz has joined the Production Department and is also on the crew of the Feathered Serpent.

PATRICIA KAMINSKI - Ms. Kaminski is from Loup City, Nebraska. She is a graduate of the University of Nebraska at Lincoln and has recently been employed as a Research and Administrative Aide for a Nebraska State Senator. She will serve in the Student Services Department which will now handle all color readings and monitor all student correspondence. Ms. Kaminski will also participate as a teacher in Phase I of the Community's School for Children.

ROGER WELD - Mr. Weld is from Greenfield, Massachusetts. He has been stationed with the United States Air Force and has recently been employed as a radio technician. Mr. Weld will work with Production as well as the Sound Department. The Sound Department is currently being expanded to be used for a recording studio and to handle multi-image motion picture productions as well as all cassette materials from symposiums and lectures.

Also joining our staff part-time beginning in July will be DR. KEN EHLE. Dr. Ehler is a research scientist and a former associate of the Salk Institute and the San Francisco General Hospital. He will organize several long-term research projects under the Community's new "Project X" program.

IBM SYSTEM 6 ACQUIRED In an effort to more effectively serve our Associates the Community has recently leased a new IBM machine which will aid our efficiency in record-keeping. IBM's System 6 will allow our administrative offices to keep all records in a centralized area for quicker and more accurate access when clerical matters arise. Thus the System 6 will assist our staff in many routine and time-consuming clerical duties so that more consideration can be given to each individual Associate on a personal basis.

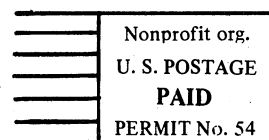
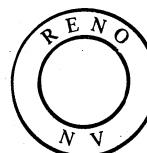
GIFTS RECEIVED AT RECTORY Several gifts of money and various beautiful house furnishings have been received at the Rectory over the past year. INCOMING WATS LINE DISCONTINUED The incoming WATS line telephone numbers, 800-648-5950 and 648-5951, have been discontinued temporarily while the Feathered Serpent is on expedition. We are recommending that all Research Associates of the Community use our other lines, either 702-786-7431 or 786-7827. We found that the WATS line did not always give our Associates sufficient time to make reports and the connections were not always good. While all incoming calls will now be at the expense of the Associate, calls are now unlimited although they should generally be held to about 15 minutes and no more than half an hour. Our staff here will answer all questions and if special answers are required from Gene Savoy, we will make arrangements to contact him via the radio telephone while at sea.
