

APOSTOLIC CHARTER

Cosolargy Internacional, A.C. (Mexico)

NOW KNOW ALL THE FAITHFUL that the Apostolic See of the Church of the Second Advent acting on behalf of the Church Community in its various capacities as the Head Overseer (Bishop) of the International Community of Christ, Church of the Second Advent, and his successors, a Nevada corporation sole; as the President of the Jamilian University of the Ordained; and as the President of the International Community of Cosolargy, collectively “The Community,” does hereby give and grant to Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, this Charter in order that said Cosolargy Internacional may serve The Community within the territory of the nation of Mexico in the capacities outlined herein as an institutional affiliate within the greater international Community of Cosolargy for the purpose of fulfilling Cosolargy’s mission and goals worldwide.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, shall come under the jurisdiction, authority and supreme governance of the Apostolic See acting as the Head Overseer (Bishop) of the International Community of Christ, Church of the Second Advent, and his successors, a Nevada corporation sole; as the President of the Jamilian University of the Ordained and the President of the International Community of Cosolargy; but that national, local and ordinary governance of Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, shall be administered by the Overseer (Bishop) of Mexico, as duly appointed by the Head Overseer (Bishop) and President of The Community.

LET IT BE KNOWN that Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, shall hold as its primary purpose the advancement of the Religious Arts, Spiritual Sciences and Therapeutic Technologies of the System of Cosolargy and The Sacred Teachings of Light. Its organizational activities shall directly carry out the tenets, functions and principles of Cosolargy and the Second Advent Church to promote activity among the members of The Community in

Mexico and the Spanish-speaking nations of the Americas as defined and governed by the Constitution and Canon of The Community; its revealed Prophecies, Revelations and Sayings; Liturgy; Institutes; Precepts and Concepts; Ethics and Codes; Declaration of Human Spiritual Rights and other such covenants that constitute the teachings and doctrines of The Community, which are universal and intended for all men and women everywhere, regardless of race, color, creed, ethnic origin, social status or religion who long to know the Sacred Teachings of Light.

AND IT IS ALSO ORDAINED that Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, is hereby authorized to establish, with approval from the Overseer (Bishop) of Mexico and in accord with the Constitution and Canon of The Community, 1) institutions of learning for the training of its members and associates; 2) establish places of worship for the practice of the divine liturgy and other rites and ceremonies; 3) erect shrines, oratories, libraries, museums and other institutional buildings or organs for the dissemination of the System of Cosolargy and the Sacred Teachings of Light throughout Mexico and the Spanish-speaking nations of the Americas; 4) own and operate health, healing and wellness centers for body, mind and Spirit; and 5) employ all lawful social means of communication to attain its proper ends.

AND, MOREOVER, that all real estate acquired for The Community in Mexico be held by a duly authorized corporation or other legal entity under the direction of the duly appointed Overseer (Bishop) of Mexico in accord with the prescriptions of the Constitution and Canon of The Community for the benefit of The Community.

FURTHER, that the ownership of all trademarks, copyrighted material and other intellectual property, such as books, illustrations, sound recordings, musical scores, designs, videos, photographs, computer presentations used by Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, with permission from The Community shall be retained by the Head Overseer (Bishop) of the International Community of Christ, Church of the Second Advent, and his successors, a Nevada corporation sole; or by the International Community of Christ, Church of the Second Advent, a Nevada nonprofit corporation, unless otherwise authorized by this See acting as the Head Overseer (Bishop) of the International

Community of Christ.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the governing board of Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, shall have authority to direct and manage the affairs of the corporation within the framework and structure of The Community in such manner which shall reflect with credit on the good name of The Community, according to the Constitution and Canon of The Community, this Charter and the laws of the United Mexican States; and that the number thereof shall include the officers of the corporation who shall be appointed and made from time to time as the Overseer (Bishop) of Mexico shall direct; and that the holder of said office, that being the Overseer (Bishop) of Mexico, shall be a permanent member of such governing board and preside over its meetings personally or through his or her duly appointed representative in Mexico;

AND that the duly appointed Overseer (Bishop) of Mexico shall have the authority to form corporations and other legal entities and to manage said corporations and legal entities within the directives herein, those of the Constitution and Canon of The Community and under the governance of the Apostolic See;

AND, FURTHER, that the governing board of Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, shall have authority to compose and adopt the articles of incorporation and bylaws of the corporation and shall also have authority to modify said articles and bylaws in accordance with the Constitution and Canon of The Community, this Charter and the laws of the Mexican republic.

BE IT ORDAINED, MOREOVER, that Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, shall be managed by its officers and directors as a fiscally independent entity, and in a responsible manner, such that no assets of The Community, held by any of its corporations, institutions, affiliates or other entities are ever placed in jeopardy by any contract or agreement, and shall be solely liable for any damages which may result from any of its activities.

THEREFORE, WE DO DECLARE that the duration of this Charter shall be

perpetual, with the caveat that all of the guidelines and restrictions contained herein shall be followed by the duly appointed Overseer (Bishop) of Mexico, and by the officers and directors of Cosolargy Internacional A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, as well as by any of its affiliated corporations, subsidiaries, organizations or other entities. Should it become necessary for this See to withdraw this Charter or should Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, be dissolved for any other reason, all assets of Cosolargy Internacional, A.C., a Mexico non-profit corporation, shall be transferred to a legal entity within The Community in such manner as this See shall determine and direct. In the event that no legal entity is available within the territory of the nation of Mexico, all teaching materials in any and all media, documents, books, items bearing trademarked designs, computer materials and files shall be returned to this See, and no other parties shall be authorized to use the name Cosolargy or any intellectual or other property of The Community or any of its affiliates in any place anywhere in the world.
