In the same year he discovered the Essene literature, Savoy began studies under an Arabian mystic, an associate of the Lebanese poet Kahlil Gibran. Unbeknown to the average reader of Gibran's poetic mysticism, the writer wove into his

works a hidden symbology. He used the same cryptic style employed by the old writers of scripture, of both the Old and the New Testaments. Savoy read into the beautiful lines of the late poet ideas that tantalized him. Beyond a doubt, Gibran had a deep knowledge of transcendental Christianity that had caused him to break from traditional teachings; as a result, the Coptic Church had excommunicated him. Savoy was driven to discover what this knowledge was. From discussions with intimates of Gibran he learned that the poet had believed himself to have been a disciple under Jesus; the latter, Gibran admitted, had appeared to him three times in his present life. The poet had confessed to Barbara Young, his secretary and associate, that he had been Judas, now returned to atone for his betrayal of the master. This atonement consisted of leaving behind a testimonial through his work. One day he was observed looking at the sun with eyes made for its bright rays. The secretary, who had seen him, was attracted to the brilliant light radiating about his person. When she inquired about it, he refused to discuss the matter and asked her to say nothing to anyone. As was customary concerning his private life, Gibran swore her to secrecy regarding this incident and the previous confession.

The Feathered Serpent III Sets Sail from Peru, December 17, 1997



Twenty-three years ago this month, the explorer Gene Savoy Sr and his crew began the Grand Ophir Sea Expedition, sailing from Callao, Peru on the Feathered Serpent III. The ship was a 73-foot double-hulled, canoe-type catamaran of ancient design, constructed by hand of Peruvian mahogany and lashed together with rope - replicating designs found on pre-Inca ceramics and traditional Polynesian craft.

The concept was to eventually sail this vessel from Peru to the Hawaiian Isles (a voyage attributed to the Incas), thence to the South Pacific and around the globe, back to South America and up the Amazon River to the Chachapoyas region of north-eastern Peru.

Savoy also aimed to establish links between the high civilizations of ancient times on the seven continents and to determine the true location of the biblical land of Ophir. This was to be a dramatic effort to demonstrate that ancient peoples were capable of sailing the open seas, using similar ships on well-known sea routes.

Setting out on December 17, the maiden voyage of the Feathered Serpent III - from Callao, Lima to Hilo, Hawaii - was accomplished in forty-two days. From there its second leg would take it onward to Samoa.

Spiritual Awareness & Spiritual Growth

In the International Community of Christ, God is not considered to be an anthropomorphic being but a totality that includes all “dimensions,” generated and un-generated. The human mind/body entity, which is to a very high-degree affected by the attributes and limitations of the third-dimensional space-time continuum, cannot normally understand or commune with an “intelligence” inherent in a form or forms and frequencies of energy that includes all dimensions of conditions of form, being, and consciousness. It is only by spiritual evolvment that Man’s consciousness develops to the degree where he, as a superior enlightened being, can love God and all mankind. This evolvment requires that the spiritual potential, which every human being is born with but which generally lies dormant or is only slightly developed, be nourished with the kind of energy that will cause it to “grow” into a Light Body that accompanies the physical-body. This process, referred to as a “new birth,” is made possible through the action of the Christ Force, acting somewhat as a catalyst does in chemical reactions, as the mediating or redeeming force between man and God. This process does not occur automatically. Man’s conscious, deliberate effort while in the physical dimension is necessary to restore the “spiritual potential” to “spiritual reality.” The result is the restoration of man as a spiritual being who can participate in the universal consciousness of God and thus experience immortality.
