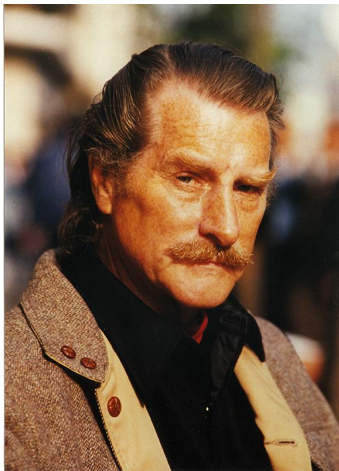

The Origins of Cosolargy

Quotes from Gene Savoy, Sr.

The mystical Gospel of Thomas contains secret words spoken by Jesus to Thomas, which again refer to the "little child." Jesus says: "Let the old man heavy with days hesitate not to ask the little child of seven days about the place of life, and he will live." At another time, Thomas asks Jesus just prior to his crucifixion: "Lord, why does the visible light which shines for men's sake, rise and set?" The Savior says, "O blessed Thomas, the visible light shines for your sakes, that you might not remain in this place, but that you might come out of it. But when all the elect lay aside the animal nature, then the light will withdraw to its true being, and its true being will take it to itself." Travels With Cosolargy

PERU 2014

The members of Cosolargy have traveled to various countries with the purpose of studying the spiritual knowledge of the peoples of the ancient and modern world in those places. One such trip was made to Peru in 2014. Many trips have been made to Peru, both archeological and as tourists. The 2014 trip was of the tourist type. Here in pictures and words is a synopsis of that trip.



Many locations were visited on this trip. I will cover just a few of my personal favorites.

Number one is the ruins of the ancient city most call Machu Picchu, although according to the guide, that is actually the name of the mountain the city is on, not the city itself. It is believed to have been built as an estate for the Inca emperor. Many interesting things are found there. One that I found intriguing was the water mirrors. These are two shallow pools that reflect like a mirror. It is thought

they were used by the royals to check on their appearance, but I suspect they might also have been used to look at the reflection of the sun.



When Hiram Bingham discovered Machu Picchu in 1911, he thought he had found the fabled lost city of the Incas -- Vilcabamba. Our own Gene Savoy, Sr. did not accept Bingham's identification of the ruins. Savoy proved his belief when, while further explored the ruins at Espiritu Pampa, he revealed the full extent of the site, identifying it as Vilcabamba Viejo, where the Incas fled after the Spanish drove them from Vitcos.

Another of my favorites was a visit to



the Nazca Lines, a network of mysterious lines and figures carved on the ground in Nazca that can only be seen from a plane or a high mountaintop. They don't allow you to walk around on the site. Instead, you have to get in a small plane a few miles away and fly over it. That gives you a better view anyway. It's hard to get good pictures because you are taking them through the window of a moving plane. Here is one of my better ones showing the spider figure near the center. No one knows what these lines were for and there are many theories.

The third most interesting site we visited was the ruins of the citadel of Sacsayhuamán. This citadel is constructed of blocks of stone in many different sizes and shapes, some as large as a city bus, yet they all fit so tightly together you can't put a knife blade between them. It is believed to have been built as a fortress to protect the city of Cusco nearby.



And just for a little fun, we rode oversized dune buggies in the desert area.
